Measurements

METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)

- Card Base thick basic white cardstock 29.7 cm by 10.5 cm scored at 14.9 cm
 - •Basic White cardstock 29.7 cm by 4.5cm scored at 7.45, 14.9cm and 22.35 cm
- for the W-Fold panels in the middle: Balmy Blue cardstock 7cm by 5.8cm (4) Basic White cardstock 5cm by 3.8cm and patterned paper 6cm by 4.8cm

- Patterned paper (3) 10cm by 14.4cm- two matching pieces for the inside and a contrasting one for the card front.
- Pear Pizzazz stitched rectangle (third largest one)
- Peach paper 9.5cm by 6.3cm
- Basic White stitched rectangle for sentiment (third smallest one 7.3cm by 2.3cm)

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- Card Base Basic White Thick Cardstock 11" by 4 1/4" scored at 5 1/2"
- Basic White Cardstock
- o 1 3/4" by 11" scored at 2 3/4", 5 1/2" and 8 1/4"
- for w-fold panels inside: Balmy Blue 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " by 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ "; Basic White 2" by 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and patterned paper 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ " by 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ ".

o three pieces dsp 4" by 5 1/4", one for the outside of the card and two matching ones for the inside.

- Pear Pizzazz stitched rectangle (third largest one)
- Peach paper 3 ¾" by 2 ½".
- Basic White stitched rectangle for sentiment (third smallest one, approximately 1/8" by 2 1/8")

Instructions

- Adhere patterned paper to card front and to both sides of the inside of your card.
- 2. Adhere peach paper to Pear Pizzazz stitched rectangle. It will be slightly off-centre to leave room for the lace trim.
- 3. Wrap lace trim around front panel overlapping slightly onto peach paper, secure on the back with adhesive.
- 4. Stamp sentiment in Calypso Coral on small stitched rectangle (or better yet, stamp on scrap of Basic White and THEN cut out with stitched rectangle die). Adhere to panel on bottom right hand corner.
- 5. Fussy cut flower branch from patterned paper and adhere on left corner of sentiment. Leave the top of this branch with no adhesive so it sort of floats above the paper.

- 6. Adhere entire panel to card front.
- 7. For W-fold part, first create your four panels. Adhere Basci white rectangles to all Balmy Blue rectangles, then adhere patterned paper of choice to each one or see photo.
- 8. Stamp sentiment in Early Espresso on scrap of Basic White and cut using small die. Stamp flowers in Calypso Coral and die cut. Stamp peach in Pale Papaya, stamp sentiment on top of peach in Calypso Coral, die cut. Stamp leaf in Pear Pizzazz and die cut. Attach stem to peach with a glue dot and pop peach up on blue panel using dimensionals. Attach flowers and small sentiment as shown below.
- 9. Adhere each rectangle in the centre between the score lines on the long Basic White W-Fold panel.
- 10. Put adhesive (I used Stampin' Seal) on the back of the first and last panel. Adhere to inside of card keeping the panel flush with the edge of the patterned paper.

Measurements

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- Card Base Pale Papaya
 - 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" score at 4 ½
- Calypso Coral
 - o 5 3/8" x 4 1/8"
 - 5 % x 4 ½ for the inside of the card
 - o 3 1/4 x 2 3/4 for the popped up layer
- DSP
 - o 5 ½ " x 4"
- Basic White
 - 3 ½ x 2 ½ layer for stamping the peach
 - 5 ½ x 4 for the inside of the card

METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)

- Card Base Pale Papaya
 - o 21.7 cm x 13.9 cm score at 10.8
- Calypso Coral
 - o 13.7 cm x 10.5 cm
 - o 8.4 cm x 6.9 cm
- DSP
 - o 13.3 cm x 10.2 cm
- Basic White
 - o 9.8 cm x 8cm and 13.3 cm x 10.2 cm for the inside of the card
 - o 7.8 cm x 6.4 cm

 Scraps in Basic Whitefor sentiment, leaves inside and peach, Petal Pink for flowers inside the card.

Instructions

- 1. Create the Pale Papaya card base and layer with Calypso Coral and dsp.
- 2. Pop the small piece of Calypso Coral onto the front of the card.
- 3. Stamp the peach leaf onto the basic white. Make sure it is close to the top of the piece.
- 4. Stamp and die cut two peaches. (Mango Melody, Cajun Craze and Pale Papaya inks). Using a dauber add the darker color to the edges and work your way to the center of the peach with the lightest color. Adhere one of the peaches onto the layer to match the leaf.
- 5. See video to color the peach pit. Pop up this peach overlapping the adhered peach.
- 6. Stamp sentiment in Calypso Coral on basic white. Die cut with small sentiment die. Tuck under the peach and pop up. Tie bow and add to the front of the card. Add Champagne Jewels to the 4 corners.

Inside of Card

- 1. Adhere Calypso Coral to the inside of the card.
- 2. Stamp sentiment in Calypso Coral on the bottom right hand corner of the Basic White layer.
- 3. Stamp leaves in Pear Pizzazz. Stamp flowers with white on Petal Pink and die cut. Adhere leaves to the top white layer, adhere flowers on the leaves. Adhere the layer to the inside of the card.

METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)

- Card Base
 - o 21 cm x 14,85 cm
 - o Score long side at 10,5cm
- Layer
 - o 9 cm x 13,35 cm
 - o DSP: 6,5cm x 10,5cm & 3cm c 8cm

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- Card Base
 - o 8-1/4" x 5-3/4"
 - o Score long side at 4-1/8"
- Layer
 - o 3-3/4" x 5-3/8"
 - o DSP: 2-1/2" x 4" & 1-1/4" x 3"

Instruction

In the first step you can cut your cardstock and your Designer Series Paper.



In the second step please punch your cardstock and choose your favourite stamp image



In the last step you just need to assemble the paper. I used dimensionals for the bigger Designer Series Paper and the punched piece. Finish your card with rhinestones.

Measurements

METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)

- Card Base Basic White Thick Cardstock
 - o 21cm x 14.8cm
- Calypso Coral Cardstock
 - o 12cm x 8cm
- Basic White Cardstock from which to cut diecut peach and leaves
 - o scrap approximately 9.9cm x 10.5cm
 - Strip approximately 9.9cm x 1.3cm (for sentiment)
- Sweet as a Peach DSP 2 pieces as follows:
 - 11.5cm x 7.5cm (striped paper)
 - 7.5cm x 2cm (dotted paper)
- White Vellum scrap from which to diecut Circle
 - o scrap approximately 9.9cm x 10.5cm

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- Card Base Basic White Thick Cardstock
 - o 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"
- Calypso Coral Cardstock
 - o 3" x 4-1/2"

- Basic White Cardstock from which to diecut peach and leaves
 - Scrap approximately 4" x 4"
 - Strip approximately 2-3/4" x 1/2" (for sentiment)
- Sweet as a Peach DSP 2 pieces as follows:
 - o 2-3/4" x 4-1/4"
 - o 2-3/4" x 1"
 - Plus scrap to die cut leaves from
- White Vellum scrap 4" x 4" (from which to diecut circle)

Instructions

- Fold White Card Base in half and set aside
- Adhere DSP striped panel to Calypso Coral cardstock piece. Add the spotted DSP strip to the bottom of the panel, so it is approximately 2cm (or ½") above the bottom. Set aside.
- Using circle shape from the Painted Labels dies, cut from White Vellum cardstock. Use blending brush to cover centre of Vellum shape with Pale Papaya ink. Set aside.
- Stamp the Largest Leaves image onto the Basic White scrap with Pear Pizazz ink and diecut with matching Die. Ink up large Peach stamp with Pale Papaya ink, and then use a sponge dauber to sponge Calypso Coral ink around the edges of the peach (on one side). Stamp this image onto the scrap of white and cut out with the matching die. Finally stamp the smaller leaves (for the top of the peach) with Pear Pizazz ink and diecut with the matching die.
- Stamp your sentiment onto the left hand side of the Basic White strip. I
 used the sentiment "To a Sweet Friend", but there are several sentiments
 in the set that would work. Add a Pale Papaya "Jewel" to the right hand
 side of the strip.
- Now we are ready to assemble the card. Adhere the large peach image onto the centre of the vellum circle with dimensionals, then add the 2 leaves to the top of the peach – also with dimensionals. I glued the large leaf image with Multi-purpose glue (or you could use Seal for this purpose)

- to the back of the vellum circle so that some of the leaves protrude from behind the circle. I then added dimensionals behind the Vellum circle and attached the whole piece to the striped cardstock panel.
- Attach the sentiment strip to the bottom of the striped panel so that it is just below the spotted DSP.
- Add dimensionals behind the Calypso coral panel and attach it to the centre of the Basic White card base.
- Your card is done! Enjoy!

 - o 21 cm x 14,9 cm
- DSP Piece
 Rectangle de papier imprimé

- A4 Cardstock Basic White Piece Rectangle de papier Blanc simple
 - o 10 x 14,4 cm

Instructions

 On the Basic white peace, create an inked background with Blending Brush + Balmy Blue and Sponge Dauber + Pale Papaya Sur le rectangle Blanc simple, créez un fond encré avec la Brosse estompe + l'encreur Béguin Bleu et un doigt éponge + l'encreur Papaye Pâle



2. With the Sweet as a peach stamp set, stamp several little flowers in Versamark and hot embossed them in white powder.

Avec le set de tampons Douceur de pêches, tamponnez plusieurs fois les petites fleurs en Versamark et embossez-les à chaud avec la poudre blanche.



- 3. In a DSP small piece, cut the big circle from Tasteful Labels dies. Stamp your sentiment in a smaller piece Basic White and create a label.

 Dans un morceau de papier imprimé, découpez le grand cercle provenant des Poinçons Chics étiquettes, tamponnez votre sentiment sur une autre découpe et superposez-les.
- 4. Cut 6 little peaches stamped in Pale Papaya, leaves in Pear Pizzaz en but them aroud your label.

 Découpez 6 petites pêches tamponnées en Papaye Pâle, les feuilles en Riche Raisin et disposez le tout autour du sentiment pour terminer votre carte.

- Floral Designer Series Paper
 - o 6.5 x 8 cm
- Basic White Cardstock
 - o 18.5 x 8 cm
 - o 1 Tasteful Touches label die cut
 - o 1 A4 to stamp on
- Striped Designer Series Paper
 - o 25 x 29.5 cm

Measurements

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- Basic White thick Cardstock slimline card base
 - 0 8 x 8.1/4 "
- Calypso Coral Cardstock
 - o 3/4" x 3"
- Dotted Designer Series Paper
 - o 5.1/4" x 3"
- Floral Designer Series Paper
 - o 2.5" x 3"
- Basic White Cardstock
 - o 7.1/4" x 3"
 - o 1 Tasteful Touches label die cut
 - o 1 sheet of cardstock to stamp on
- Striped Designer Series Paper
 - o 9.¾" x 11.½ "

Instructions

Place the 8" side of your card to the top of your trimmer

Plaats de 21 cm zijde tegen de bovenkant van je snijmachine met rilfunctie

• Score @ 4"

Ril op 10.5 cm

Fold the card in half

• Take out your Basic white piece 7.1/4" x 3"

Pak je witte papier in de maat 18.5 x 8 cm

- Glue on the right side the dotted designer paper measuring 5.¼" x 3"
 Plak aan de rechter kant het gestipte papier in de maat 13.5 x 8 cm
- Glue on the left side the floral dsp measuring 2.5" x 3". This has an overlap with the other dsp.

Plak aan de linkerkant het gebloemde papier in de maat 6.5 x 8 cm. Dit overlapt het gestipte papier enigszins.

• Glue the Calypso Coral cardstock piece measuring ³/₄" x 3" on top of the overlapping part.

Lijm het stuk Calypso Coral kaartkarton in de maat ¾" x 3" over het overlappende deel heen.

• Cut a piece of you white cardstock to stamp the small sentiments on with Momento Black ink.

Snijd een stuk van het witte karton af waarop je de kleine tekstjes kunt stempelen met Memento black inkt.

- Cut out the small sentiments with the small label die in the Peach Dies Snijd deze tekstjes uit met de kleine label mal uit de Perzik stansenset.
- Cut a strip of ½" x 2.¼" and stamp Happy Birthday in Calypso Coral.

Snijd een strook van 2 x 5 cm en stempel hierop de Happy Birthday tekst in Calypso Coral



• Ink up the peach stamps with Pale Papaya ink. Use a sponge dauber to add some shading on one side of the stamp with Calypso Coral ink. When ready, stamp on your paper and die cut with matching peach dies. Beinkt de perzikstempel met Pale Papaya inkt. • Stamp the leaves with Pear Pizzaz ink and cut them out with the matching die.

- Use dimensionals to glue the Tasteful Touches label onto your card. Gebruik dimensionals (3-d blokjes) om het Tasteful Touches label op je kaart te plakken.
- Use partially mini dimensionals and partially glue to assemble the peaches and sentiments onto the label as shown in the photo above. Gebruik mini dimensionals en lijm om de perzikken en de tekstjes op het label plakken, zoals op de foto hierboven.
- With the Striped Designer Series Paper we're going to create a matching envelope.

Met het gestreepte designpapier gaan we een bijpassende envelop maken.



• Put the paper onto your trimmer with the 9.¾" side to the top of your trimmer and score at 2.5" inch.

Leg het papier met de 25 cm zijde tegen de bovenrand van je snijmachine en ril op 6.5 cm.

- Turn the paper 180 degrees and score at 2.5" again.

 Draai je papier 180 graden om en ril opnieuw op 6.5 cm.
- Turn your paper so the 11.5" is at the top of your trimmer and score at 3/4" Draai je papier zodanig, dat de 29.5 cm zijde bovenaan je trimmer ligt en ril op 2 cm.
- Turn the paper 180 degrees and score at 2".

Draai je papier 180 graden en ril op 5 cm

- Cut away the corners as shown in the photo above Knip de hoeken af, zoals op de foto.
- Cut the 2 outer flaps in an angle as shown on the photo above. Knip een hoek af van de buitenste flappen, zoals op de foto hierboven.
- Fold into an envelope

Vouw de envelop.

• Glue the middle first and then the small part, which will be the bottom of your envelope. Make sure you DON'T glue the bigger flap just yet. You want to be able to put the card inside before you glue that one. :)

Lijm eerst het midden vast, daarna het kleine randje. Dat wordt de bodem. Lijm de grote flap nog NIET, want je wilt eerst je kaart geschreven erin doen. :)

- Card Base Basic White
 - o 21.59 cm x 13.97 cm
- Layer Early Espresso
 - o 11.43 cm x 8.26 cm
- Layer Basic White
 - o 10.80 x 7.62
- Scraps of Basic White for stamping the leaves, peaches and sentiment
- Scraps of Pear Pizzazz for die cutting leaves
- Scraps of Pale Papaya for die cutting flowers

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- Card Base Basic White
 - \circ 8 ½" x 5 ½"
- Layer Early Espresso
 - o 4 ½" x 3 ¼"
- Layer Basic White
 - o 4 1/4" x 3"
- Scraps of Basic White for stamping the leaves, peaches and sentiment
- Scraps of Pear Pizzazz for die cutting leaves
- Scraps of Pale Papaya for die cutting flowers

Instructions:

• Fold your Basic White card base in half. Burnish well with your bone folder for a nice, crisp fold.

• First we do a bit of stamping and prepare our layer:

 Using your Sahara Sand ink and the "To a sweet friend!" sentiment, stamp 7-9 times in various spots on your Basic White layer. As your peach arrangement will be covering much of the bottom left corner of your layer, try to place your stamped sentiments around the area where your peaches will go (so the sentiments can be seen).



• Adhere the Basic White layer to the Early Espresso layer using the adhesive of your choice.

• Attach the Basic Black layer to the card base using dimensionals.

• Now we stamp and cut out our peaches, flowers and leaves:

- Using your Pale Papaya Ink, stamp the three small peaches on a scrap of Basic White card stock and cut them out with the coordinating dies. Set aside.
- Using your Pear Pizzazz Ink, stamp the large branch of leaves on a scrap of Basic White card stock and cut it out with the coordinating die. Set aside.
- Die cut several leaves from Pear Pizzazz card stock using the double and single leaf dies. (I cut two of the small double-leaf ones and one of the single leaf ones). Set aside.
- Die cut several of the teeny tiny flowers from your scrap of Pale Papaya card stock using the dies. Set aside.

• Now we do some gluing and attaching:

- Glue the large leaf image to your card layer using the adhesive of your choice. I used liquid glue.
- Attach your three peaches to the leaf image using dimensionals
- Attach three of the teeny tiny flowers using liquid glue. I used the
 putty end of my Take Your Pick Tool to pick up the flowers, add the
 glue and place them on the card.
- Attach the leaves under the top right hand corner of your Early Espresso layer. (See photo)
- Using your Take Your Pick Tool, attach the smallest pearls to the centres of the flowers and one to one of the peaches. (See photo)
- Cut a piece of White Bakers Twine approx 12" long.
 - We are going to "curl" it.
 - Grab your paper snips and, similar to how one curls ribbon for a package, hold the twine between your thumb and the edge of your paper snips and pull the twine against the edge of the snips. (See picture below). This may take a bit of practice to get it to curl. You can press too hard nor too lightly or it won't curl.
 - Tie your piece of twine into a bow with nice, long tails.

Attach the twine to the top of your branch of leaves, using a glue dot.



Now we stamp and attach our sentiment:

- o Grab a piece of scrap Basic White card stock.
- With Early Espresso Ink, stamp the "sweet as a peach" sentiment.
- With Early Espresso Ink, stamp the "hope your day is as" right above (and to the left) the "sweet as a peach" stamped image
- Using your Paper Snips, cut around the sentiment.
- Using dimensionals and mini dimensionals, attach your sentiment to your card.

• Ta-Da! Done!




Instructions



 Fold and burnish card base then open it back up and lay it flat. On the right side which will be the front of the card, lay the template down in the upper right hand corner. (see illustration)



• Take a pencil and lightly mark from the tic mark on the template left down and around to the tic mark on the template bottom right. (see illustration)




 Take a cutting board or mat and a craft knife or you can use your trimmer (see illustration)



• Cut on the line you marked from the template (see illustration)



• Push in and over on the corner incision, then fold flat making sure it's straight with the left side of the card front. (see illustrations)



• Fussy cut 2 bunches of peaches and 3 sections of flowers from the DSP (see illustration of the two DSP sheets I'm referring to)



- Layer the White, Bumblebee and DSP (the one with the peaches on it in the above illustration) in that order on top of the fold down corner section.. Use Seal for this
- Punch out a piece of White using the Rectangular Postage Stamp Punch
- Stamp the sentiment "Thanks for being as" at the top of the punched out piece. Attach to the front square section using dimensionals. I put mine at an angle.
- Take one of the fussy cut peach bunches and add to the front square section. You will need to glue parts and then put dimensionals on the parts that hang off the rectangle piece.
- Add gems and a bow
- Add the piece of stripe DSP you cut to the bottom section of the card front and then two pieces of the fussy cut flowers.

Inside



- Take the stripe piece of DSP you cut for the inside left square and add using Seal. I flipped the corner back around to front and added the DSP and then flipped it back to the inside
- Add one section of the fussy cut flowers
- Add the Dot DSP to the right side of the inside of the card base. Use Seal
- Glue the last bunch of fussy cut peaches to the White card stock that you cut for the inside and stamp the "Sweet as a Peach" sentiment using Bumblebee Ink in the top right corner.
- Attach the White card stock and the Bumblebee card stock together with glue then add to the Dots DSP making sure you line it up so it can't be seen when the card is closed.
- Add a bow

- Calypso Coral, 11 X 4-1/4, score at 1-1/2 and 5-1/2. Fold on the 5-1/2 score line and fold the 1-1/2 score line the opposite way.
- You're a Peach DSP, 3-¾ X 2-¾, layer on a piece of Basic White, 3-¾ X 2-½.
 Adhere to the front of the card base.
- Basic White, ¾ X 4-¼, die cut using the Peony Dies. Adhere to the bottom flap. Then adhere the flap down with Multi-purpose Liquid Glue.
- You're a Peach DSP, 3-¾ X 1, layer on a piece of Basic White, 3-⅓ X 1-⅓.
 Adhere to the front of the card base.
- Wrap a piece of ribbon around the card base and tie a bow in the front.
- Calypso Coral, 2 X 2, die cut the scalloped circle using the Layering Circle Dies. Adhere to the card front with Dimensionals.
- Basic White, die cut using the Layering Circles Dies (1-5/8 X 1-5/8), adhere to a Pear Pizzazz circle, (1-3/4 X 1-3/4). Layer on the scalloped circle.
- Basic White scrap, ink up the peach with Pale Papaya Ink. Next, place the stamp on the Flirty Flamingo Ink. Stamp the image and die cut. Adhere to the card front with Dimensionals.
- Basic White scrap, stamp the leaves with Pear Pizzazz Ink. Die cut and adhere to the card front with Dimensionals.
- Basic White, ¾ X 1, stamp the sentiment with Pear Pizzazz Ink. Adhere to the card front with Dimensionals.

Inside of the Card

- Basic White, 5 X 3-3/4, stamp the peach and leaf images.
- Stamp the sentiment with Calypso Coral Ink.
- Layer on a piece of Calypso Coral, 5-1/8 X 3-1/8. Insert in the card base.

8½" x 5¾" (21cm x 14.6cm) scored and folded at 4½" (10.5cm) Top Layer - 1 piece inside card 5½" x 3¾" (13.6cm x 9.5cm) Centre Embossed Strip 5½" x 1¾" (13.6cm x 4.5cm) Scraps for sentiment and image

Calypso Coral Cardstock

Middle Layer - 2 includes one inside card 5½" x 3½" (13.9cm x 9.8cm) Sentiment layer - 1" x 3" (2.5cm x 7.5cm)

Instructions

- 1). Create the card base by scoring at and folding in half. Burnish with bone folder to get crisp fold.
- 2). Emboss the Basic White centre strip with the Tasteful Textile 3D Embossing Folder.
- 3). On a scrap of Basic White, stamp the large leaves stamp in Pear Pizzazz and then stamp the three peaches stamp in Calypso Coral. Then die-cut using the largest circle die from the **Stitched Shapes Dies.
- 4). Using the two largest **Encircled in Beauty Dies and Calypso Coral die-cut the doily. Adhere the image to the centre of the doily.
- 5). On another scrap of Basic White, stamp the HAPPY BIRTHDAY sentiment using Calypso Coral. Die-cut using the no 2 slim die from the Stitched Rectangle Dies. Adhere to the Calypso Coral layer.
- 6). On the Basic White top layer, stamp on the right-hand side the leaves stamp twice. *NOTE: I started my first stamp too high and finished up with a gap between the two images. I will avoid this next time.* Adhere this layer to a Calypso Coral middle layer and adhere to the inside of the card base.
- 7). Adhere the DSP to the second Calypso Coral middle layer and adhere to the card front. Adhere the embossed Basic White strip in the centre of the DSP. Adhere the image and sentiment using Dimensionals.
- 8). I fussy cut the two pairs of leaves I used to decorate the sentiment from a stamped image of the large leaves. If this doesn't rock your boat, die-cut two sets of double leaves from the set of dies using a scrap of Pear Pizzazz cardstock.
- 9). I painted two small Basic Pearl Jewels using the Dark Calypso Coral Stampin' Blend and adhered one each on the pairs of leaves as if they were berries, or maybe baby peaches!

10). Finally, adhere two Bumblebee Trinkets to the peach image using Glue Dots and a small dot of Tombow. Not that the bumblebees will find any pollen there!!

- 2. With the matted layer, stamp the small floral stamp across the card in coordinating ink.
- 3. Select two of the papers in the Hand-Penned Designer Series paper can cut to 9.5 cm x 7 cm & 9.5 cm x 6 cm. Tire along the bottom edge of each DSP and crinkle the paper.
- 4. Adhere the two DSP's pieces together and attach to the mat later. Taking the Linen Thread, wrap around the mat later and finish in a bow.
- Take a piece of Basic White Card and stamp the peach shape in Calypso Carol Ink, I used a blending brush to get a smooth image. The leaves will need to be stamped in Pear Pizzazz.
- 6. Before die cutting stamp your sentiment also in Pear Pizzazz. Die cut the stamped shapes and your sentiment.
- 7. Arrange on your mat layer and adhere to your mat layer. You can attach the mat layer to the card base.



Instructions

- 1. Die cut a large circle from Thick Basic White Cardstock. Die cut a large coordinating scalloped circle from the Rose Gold Metallic Specialty Paper. Stamp the white circle with the leaves from the Sweet as a Peach Stamp Set in Granny Apple Green Ink. Adhere this circle to the scalloped circle. On a scrap of Thick Basic White, stamp some peaches, inking them in Pale Papaya and using a Sponge Dauber to add some Mango Melody ink to the edges stamp the peaches. Die cut these peaches using the coordinating dies. Adhere the peaches where shown with Stampin' Dimensionals. Stamp the sentiment twice, once in Memento Black and one in Pumpkin Pie. Fussy cut the sentiment out as shown. Die cut the label in Basic Black from the Peach Dies and adhere this where shown before adhering the sentiment over the top. Die cut some of the small flowers in Shimmer Vellum from the Peach Dies, adhere these to the circle, add In Colour Jewels to the centres. Set this circle aside.
- 2. Take the piece of Linen Paper and using a Blending Brush and Mango Melody Ink, ink from the bottom in a circular motion focusing the majority of the ink on the bottom for an ombre affect. Once this is inked, adhere onto the Basic Black cardstock. Adhere this to the larger layer of Basic White. Adhere this to the card base with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 3. Take the Pale Papaya Ribbon, Linen Thread and Simply Elegant Trim, and cut lengths the length of the card as shown and adhere these along the join of the Basic Black and Linen Paper using either Stampin' Seal or Tear & Tape Adhesive or use the tip shown in the video and do this step prior to adhering to the card. Take some Wink of Stella and spritz over the card for some sparkle!
- 4. Take your embellished circle completed in step one and adhere to the card using some Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 5. To decorate the inside of the card, I have stamped some of the flowers from the Sweet as a Peach stamp set by inking them up in Flirty Flamingo

Ink and then using a sponge dauber to add some Mango Melody before stamping on the card. I have added a strip of the Rose Gold Speciality Paper to the bottom of the card and added some Linen Thread before adhering this to the layer of Basic Black. I have then added a sentiment stamped in Memento Black.

 - \circ 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{5}{8}$ "
- Basic White Thick Cardstock for sentiments of your choice
- You're a Peach Designer Series Paper
 - \circ 5 1/8 " x 3 1/2 "

Instructions



 Score the Basic White Cardstock base at 14.85cm and reinforce the crease with a Bone Folder.

- 2. Add dimensionals to the Basic White Cardstock and adhere to the card base at an angle. Squish the bottom right corner of your card upwards to create the fold shown in the picture above.
- 3. Use the edge of your paper snips, or use your fingernail, and rough up the edges of the Designer Series Paper. Adhere the DSP at an angle and squish the bottom right corner as you've done above.
- 4. Use your Layering Circle Dies to create two Basic White Circle die cuts and adhere with dimensionals. You can place these circles where you like.
- 5. Choose some peach, flower and leaf images from the You're A Peach Designer Series Paper and fussy cut them out. Alternatively if you have the matching dies from the Peach Dies, you can die cut out some images using your Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
- 6. Add dimensionals to the back of each of the images and raise up on the circles.
- 7. Stamp the sentiments in Black Memento Ink and raise up the sentiments with dimensionals.

 - Card Base 5" x 11" scored @ 4 ¼"
- Basic White
 - Front layer 4 ½" X 5 ¾"
 - Circle Border 4" x 4"
 - Sentiment ½" x 3 ½"
- Thick Basic White
 - Inside folding layer 5" x 8" Scored on the long side @ 2", 3 ½", 5 ½"
- You're A Peach Designer Series Paper
 - Front Panel 4" x 5 ¼"
 - Inner left panel (blue pattern) 1 ¼" x 4 ¾"
 - Inner right panel (green pattern) 1 ¾ x 4 ¾

METRIC -


- Pale Papaya
 - Card Base 14cm x 21.5cm scored @ 10.8cm
- Basic White
 - Front layer 10.5cm x 13.65cm
 - Circle Border 10cm x 10 cm
 - Sentiment 1.3cm x 8.9cm
- Thick Basic White
 - o Inside folding layer 14cm x 28cm scored @ 5, 8.9, 13.9 cm
- You're A Peach Designer Series Paper
 - Front Panel 10cm x 13.3cm
 - o Inner left panel (blue pattern) 3.2cm x 12.1cm
 - Inner right panel 4.5cm x 12.1cm

Instructions

- 1. Use the largest scalloped rectangle from the So Sweetly Stitched Dies from the upper center of the Basic White layering panel. This will reduce the thickness of the card front and make it easier to cut the circle later. If you don't have the So Sweetly Stitched Dies, you can use another large die, or your Paper Trimmer to cut out the center.
- Adhere the Designer Series Paper layer to the Basic White layer, and then
 on to the front of the card. Avoid using adhesive in the area you plan to cut
 out the circle, so that you can save the Pale Papaya circle for the
 embossed piece.
- 3. Use the second to the largest circle die from the Layering Circles to cut out a window in the front of the card.
- 4. To cut out the Basic White circle layer, use the two largest circle dies, the smaller one nested inside the larger one, and cut it at the same time.

 Adhere it to the front of the card.
- 5. Emboss the Pale Papaya circle with the Macrame 3D Folder and set aside with the rest of the card.
- 6. You can use the piece you cut out to stamp the peach and leaf on. Stamp the peach in the Pale Papaya ink, and use a Sponge Dauber to add some Calypso Coral to the lower, outer edge of the peach to add some dimension before stamping it on the Basic White Cardstock.
- 7. Ink the leaf image with Pear Pizzazz ink, and then use a cotton swab to remove the ink from the stem area. Use the brush end of the Early Espresso Stampin' Write Marker to color in the stem, then stamp on to the Basic White.
- 8. Cut out the peach and the leaf and stem using the coordinating Dies.
- 9. Stamp the sentiment in Early Espresso ink on the Basic White piece. Detail the edges with the Banners Pick a Punch.
- Adhere the Designer Series Paper layers to the Basic White Thick cardstock. As shown below.

- 11. To assemble the inside, do a "mountain" fold at the 3 ½" score line, and a "valley" fold at the 5 ½" score. Keep it folded. Add glue on the back of the to the right of the green panel. You should be able to center the Basic White evenly on the top, right, and bottom sides, with the left edge of the Basic White cardstock. Sitting at the center crease of the card.
- 12. Adhere a very thin line of adhesive along the top, left, and bottom edge of the far left side panel of the Basic White Cardstock, and then close the card, so that it will be glued to the inside of the front of the card. When you open the card, be careful to bend back the cardstock at the first score line. See photos below.
- 13. With the card closed, add adhesive to the inside of the window, only on the blue Designer Series Paper area showing. This will let the circle swing freely when the card opens and closes.
- 14. Continue to assemble the front of the card, by adding the peach to the Pale Papaya circle with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 15. Fold the Linen Thread in half, and tie in to a bow. Add to the back of the sentiment with a Glue Dot. Add the sentiment to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 16. Embellish with Genial Gems.
