- Two bands
  - 1"  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 11"  $\frac{1}{4}$
  - 1" x 11"  $\frac{1}{4}$

#### *Deux bandes*

- 3,8 x 28,6 cm
- 2,6 x 28,6 cm

1. Cut 2 bands in the Blackberry Beauty DSP.

*Découpez deux bandes dans le papier Autour des mûres, une de et l'autre de.  
Pliez avec le coupe-papier tous les*



2. Stamp 3 flowers from Beauty of tomorrow stamp set in Blackberry Bliss. Then Color inside flowers with the Blender pens. Cut with Beautiful Leaves Dies.

*Tamponnez 3 fleurs du set de tampons Beauté de demain en Cuvée de cassis.  
Puis avec le Crayon-estompe, coloriez l'intérieur de la fleur. Découpez avec les  
Poinçons Feuilles magnifiques.*



3. In the Gold Shimmer Vellum, cut some leaves and a bird in the DSP.  
*Dans le papier Vélín scintillant or découpez quelques feuilles. Puis découpez l'oiseau dan le papier Design.*



4. Form both roundel and glue them on each other. Place under the small one, leaves and flowers.  
*Formez les deux cocardes et collez-les l'une sur l'autre légèrement décalée. Puis disposez les différentes découpes fleurs et feuilles sous la plus petite cocarde.*





5. Cut 3 leaves in the DSP with scissors and glue them in the middle of the small roundel. Stamp a sentiment and glue it on the leaves. Place the bird in the corner.

*Découpez 3 feuilles dans le papier Design et collez-les sur la plus petite cocarde. Tamponnez un sentiment et collez-le sur les feuilles. Puis placez l'oiseau dans un coin.*

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# Measurements

## IMPERIAL & METRIC (for A4 Cardstock)

### Basic Grey Cardstock

Card base - 4 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (10.5cm x 29.2cm) scored and folded at 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " (14.6cm)

### Basic White Cardstock

Lower panel inside card -  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{3}{8}$ " (4.5cm x 13.7cm)  
Scraps for 6 gold embossed Wise Men (2 of each) plus 3 non-embossed Wise Men (just plain Basic White Cardstock)  
Scrap for sentiment on front of card

### Brushed Metallic Cardstock

Layer under the Designer Series Paper on the front of the stable door -  $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (4.8cm x 14cm)  
Middle layer inside card (under the Black Glitter layer) -  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (9.9cm x 14cm)  
Scraps for 3 Wise Men die-cut in reverse, star, layer for sentiment and seven small palms to decorate front of stable door

### Simply Elegant Designer Series Paper

Front of stable door -  $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{3}{8}$ " (4.2cm x 13.7cm)

### Black Glitter Paper

Top layer for top part inside card -  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{3}{8}$ " (5.7cm x 13.7cm)



## **IMPERIAL (for Letter-size Cardstock)**

### Basic Grey Cardstock

Card base - 4¼" x 11" scored and folded at 5½"

### Basic White Cardstock

Lower panel inside card - 1¾" x 5¼"

Scraps for six gold embossed Wise Men (2 of each) plus 3 non-embossed Wise Men (just plain Basic White Cardstock)

Scrap for sentiment

### Brushed Metallic Cardstock

Layer under the Designer Series Paper on front of stable door - 1⅞" x 5¼"

Middle layer inside card (under Black Glitter layer) - 4" x 5¼"

Scraps for 3 Wise Men die-cut in reverse, star, layer for sentiment and seven small palms to decorate front of stable door

### Simply Elegant Designer Series Paper

For front of stable door - 1⅝" x 5⅞"

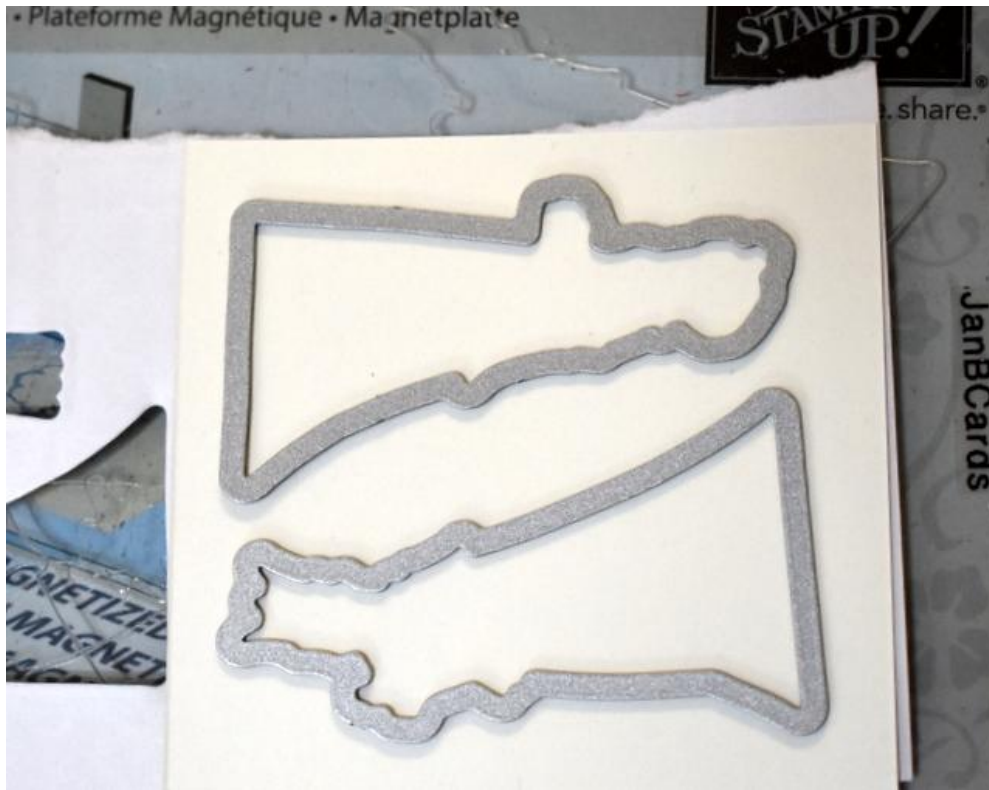
### Black Glitter Paper

Top layer for top part of inside card - 2¼" x 5⅞"



# Instructions

- 1). Score card base in half but don't fold.
- 2). Place card base in trimmer on landscape side and cut down from top to 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ " (5.3cm) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " removing score line. Turn the card anti-clockwise so the first cut is on the left-hand side. Line the vertical edge up at 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ " (5.3cm) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " and cut down to meet up with the first cut line. Save offcut for another project.
- 3). Adhere all the layers on the stable door and inside the card. NOTE: after adhering the Burnished Metallic layer, add the Basic White layer, then the Black Glitter layer.
- 4). Wipe over Basic White Cardstock with your embossing buddy and then stamp 6 Wise Men, i.e. 2 of each, with Versamark. Sprinkle with Gold Embossing Powder, knock off excess and heat-emboss using Heat Tool.
- 5). Wipe over another scrap of Basic White Cardstock with your embossing buddy and then stamp the sentiment "WISE MEN STILL SEEK HIM" with Versamark. Sprinkle with Gold Embossing Powder, knock off excess and heat-emboss using Heat Tool.
- 6). Die-cut the six embossed Wise Men using the Wise Men Tidings Dies and the sentiment using the no. 1 slim die from the Stitched Rectangle Dies.
- 7). Die-cut three Wise Men (one of each) using Basic White Cardstock.
- 8). Die-cut seven palm plants to decorate the bottom of the stable door, using the Brushed Metallic Cardstock
- 9). Die-cut three Wise Men (one of each) in reverse using the Brushed Metallic Cardstock. HOW TO: lay a piece of scrap paper on your first cutting mat and lay your piece of gold metallic cardstock on top, face down. Lay the dies face down on the white backing of the gold metallic cardstock. See photograph below. Run through your Cut & Emboss Machine.



10). Die-cut a gold metallic cardstock star and adhere in the top left-hand corner of Black Glitter Paper. Use either Glue Dots or Tombow, which will need a small weight on it for a few minutes.

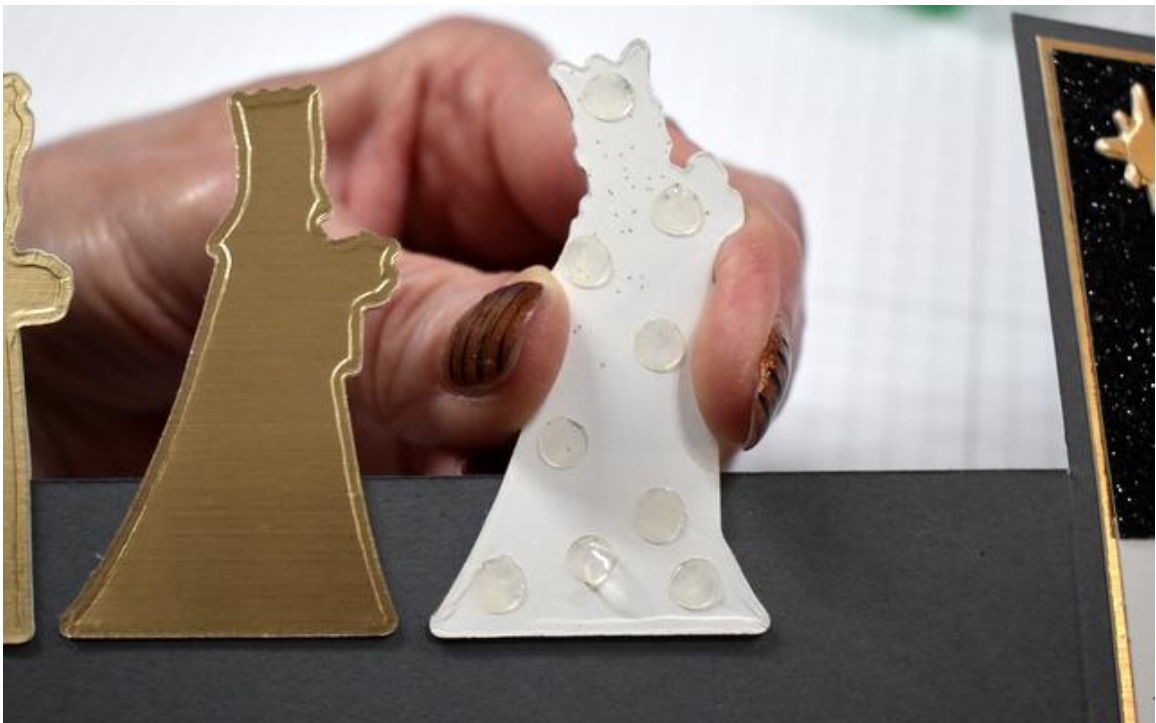


11). Position three of the gold-embossed Wise Men (one of each) on the closed stable door and adhere in place with Tombow when happy with positioning.

12). Adhere the plain Basic White Wise Men from no. 7). to the back of the three Wise Men you have adhered to the front of the stable door.

13). Adhere the three gold metallic Wise Men to the back of the corresponding plain white three Wise Men.

14). Work on one gold-embossed Wise Man at a time. Add some Glue Dots to the back of the first Wise Man. Line the front of this image up with the back of the corresponding gold metallic image - see photograph below:-



15). Next, you need to adhere the gold-embossed Wise Men onto the Black Glitter layer immediately behind those that are adhered onto the stable door. This is how to do it:

When you have lined the first gold-embossed Wise Man to the corresponding gold metallic Wise Man (that's on the stable door) perfectly, use your other hand to hold the outside edges of the head and close the

stable door so you cannot see the outline of the Wise Man on the Black Glitter. See the photograph below of the closed card.



15). Using Mini Dimensionals, adhere the palm plants along the bottom of Designer Series Paper on the stable door. Then add the sentiment above, or over, the plants using Dimensionals.

# Measurements

## **METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)**

- Card Base – Gray Granite Cardstock
  - 29.5cm x 10.5cm
- Basic Gray Cardstock
  - 13.6cm x 9.4cm
- Basic White Thick Cardstock
  - 13.3cm x 9.1cm
- Basic Gray Cardstock
  - 10cm x 2cm
- Peaceful Place Designer Series Paper
  - 10cm x 3cm
- Basic White Cardstock
  - 13.3cm x 9.1cm for inside of the card

# Instructions

1. Score the Gray Granite Cardstock at 14.75cm
2. Take a Blending Brush and Pool Party Ink and shade the Basic White Cardstock around the area where the cones and leaves will sit.
3. On a separate piece of Basic White Cardstock stamp the base stamp of the two-step pine cone image in Gray Granite Ink twice. Then take the second more detailed image and ink up the stamp with Blackberry Bliss Ink. Stamp over the top of the gray granite. Use the dies or fussy cut them out.
4. Take some Evening Evergreen Ink and ink up the leaves image and stamp twice. Either use the dies or fussy cut out.
5. Take a sentiment of choice - I've used one from the Frosted Gingerbread Stamp Set - and stamp with Black Memento Ink. Cut this sentiment out with a circle die.
6. Take the shaded Basic White Cardstock and adhere to the Basic Gray Cardstock. Then adhere this to the Gray Granite Cardstock.
7. Take the Basic Gray Cardstock strip and glue to the card off-centre. Then adhere the DSP, also off-centre.
8. Take a strip of Gilttered Organdy Ribbon, arrange on your card and stick with Glue Dots.

9. Layer the leaves and pine cones with Dimensionals.
10. Add Dimensionals to the back of the sentiment and add to your card.
11. Place one, two, three or even more Basic Pearls to your card.

# Measurements

## **METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)**

- Card Base – thick Very Vanilla cardstock 21 cm by 14.9 cm scored at 10.5 cm
  - Very Vanilla cardstock 10.5 cm by 14.9cm
  - Scrap of Very Vanilla for sentiment. Extra Very Vanilla for die cutting the flowers.

## **IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)**

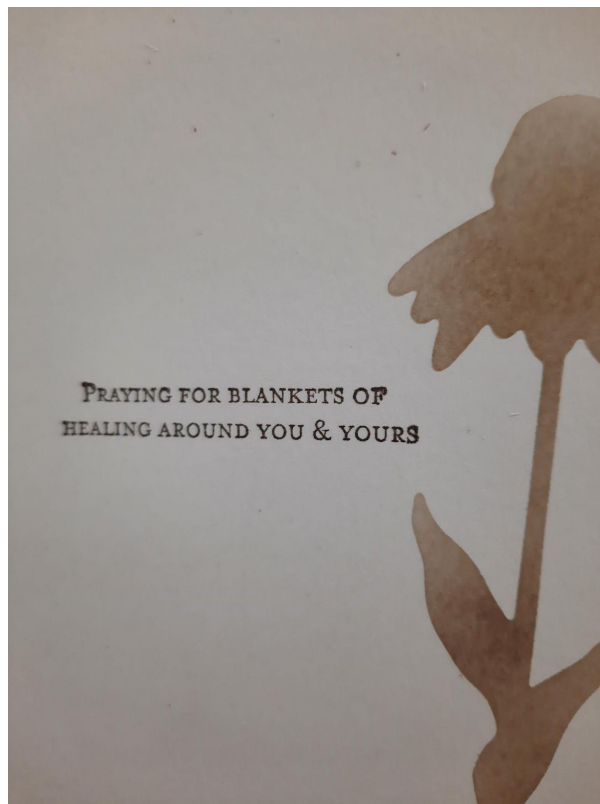
- Card Base – Very Vanilla Thick Cardstock 8 ½” by 5 ½” scored at 4 ¼”
- Very Vanilla Cardstock 4 ¼” by 5 ½”.

# Instructions

1. Put your Very Vanilla cardstock layer through the Timeworn Type embossing folder in your die cutting machine.
2. Use your Blending Brushes to apply soft suede ink all over giving extra pressure to the outside edges for a vintage look. Adhere to your card base using liquid glue being careful to get all your edges!
3. Die cut your flowers using scraps of Very Vanilla cardstock. Use your Blends to colour the stems using Old Olive Blends. Use Misty Moonlight Blends to colour the one flower. For the other flower, stamp with “splatter” stamp in Bumblebee. Add Shimmery Crystal Effects and allow to dry completely. Die cut a branch using a scrap of Early Espresso cardstock.
4. Adhere your flowers to the card using a sponge, some liquid glue and your silicone craft sheet. Start with the Misty Moonlight flower, then the Bumblebee flower and lastly the Early Espresso branch.
5. Stamp your sentiment in Soft Suede on a scrap of Very Vanilla. Cut out using die from bundle. Put some adhesive on the back of your die cut and adhere scrap of Diamond Weave trim (about 3” or 8cm) being sure to leave half exposed at the bottom. Allow to dry and then pop up with dimensionals

over the stems.

6. Tie a double bow using some linen thread and adhere with a glue dot above the sentiment.
7. Finish your card with some Brushed Metallic dots.
8. In the inside of your card use a mask made from die cutting the single flower die and sponging in the negative space using Soft Suede ink and your blending brush. Stamp sentiment (I used “Praying for blankets of healing around you & yours” from Through It Together.)

## **METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)**

- Card Base – Basic White Thick
- Basic White
  - 14.1cm x 9.7cm x 2 pieces
  - Scrap piece for stamping and die cutting
- Basic Black
  - 14.3 x 9.9cm x 2 pieces
- Vellum Cardstock
  - 14.1cm x 9.7cm x 1 pieces
- Adhesive Sheet
  - 14.1cm x 9.7cm x 1 pieces
- Rose Gold/Gold Metallic Specialty Paper
  - 9.7cm x .5cm x 1 piece

## **IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)**

- Card Base – Basic White Thick
- Basic White
  - 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" x 2 pieces
  - Scrap piece for stamping and die cutting
- Basic Black
  - 4" x 5 1/4 x 2 pieces
- Vellum Cardstock
  - 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" x 1 pieces
- Adhesive Sheet
  - 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" x 1 pieces
- Rose Gold/Gold Metallic Specialty Paper
  - 3 7/8" x 1/4" x 1 piece

# Instructions

1. Take your piece of Vellum Cardstock and the Daffodil Delight, Cinnamon Cider and Pale Papaya Stampin' Blends. I have used the brush tip end of each of these blends to scribble colour the entire left-hand side of the vellum piece being sure not to overlap the colour. Once you have applied the colour, take some rubbing alcohol (at least 99% alcohol) and drip this over the piece. It is handy to use some washi tape to help hold your piece down to prevent curling. I have also used an air blowing tool to move some of the colour, then use a Heat Tool to help dry this piece. Once dry, add some Liquid Glue to where some of the harder lines are on the dried piece and set this aside to dry. Once dry take a 1/4 of a Stampin' Sponge and the Gilded Leaf and rub this onto where the glue is dried on your piece in a circular motion. See the video link at the bottom of this tutorial for tips and tricks on this step. I have then taken one of the layers of Basic White and my layer of Adhesive Sheet and applied this to my layer of Basic White to adhere the whole decorated Vellum piece to. Then adhere this to a layer of Basic Black and adhere to the card base with Stampin' Dimensionals.
2. Taking a scrap piece of Basic White. Stamp the large foliage image in Cinnamon Cider, the small bird in Mint Macaron and the smaller foliage image in Memento Black. I have then added some Wink of Stella to my bird and coloured my small foliage image with a mixture of Old Olive and Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends. Die cut all these images out with the coordinating dies. Adhere the large Cinnamon Cider image with Liquid glue where shown. Add a gold piece from the Blackberry Beauty Ephemera Pack over the top with glue. Lastly add the coloured foliage image over the top of these pieces. Take a label from the ephemera pack and stamp one of the sentiments onto this in Memento Black and adhere where shown on the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
3. Take some of the Gold Shimmer Ribbon and tie a bow with this and trim the tails. Add this to the left-hand side of the sentiment and adhere to the card with a Mini Glue Dot.

4. Add the small bird up to the right-hand side of the focal points. To further decorate I have added some spritzes of Wink of Stella and added some Metallic Pearls.
5. To decorate the inside of the card, I have added a strip of the Gold Speciality Paper and stamped the bird. I have then added this to Basic Black and adhered to inside of the card.

## **METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)**

- Card Base – Crumb Cake Cardstock
  - 14.9 cm x 21 cm
  - 5 cm x 11.5 cm for die cut chicory flower
- Misty Moonlight Cardstock
  - 10 cm x 14.4 cm
  - 7 cm x 7 cm
  - 5 cm x 11.5 cm for die cut chicory flower
- Harvest Meadow DSP
  - 9.5 cm x 13.9 cm
- Basic White Cardstock
  - 6.5 cm x 6.5 cm
  - 2.5 cm x 5 cm piece for die cut sentiment label

## **IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)**

- Card Base – Crumb Cake Cardstock
  - 5 ½" x 8 ½"; score at 4 ¼" and fold
  - 2" x 4 ½" for die cut chicory flower
- Misty Moonlight Cardstock
  - 4" x 5 ¼"
  - 3" x 3"
  - 2" x 4 ½" for die cut chicory flower
- Harvest Meadow DSP
  - 3 ¾" x 5"
- Basic White Cardstock
  - 2 ¾" x 2 ¾"
  - 1" x 2" piece for die cut sentiment label

# Instructions

- Cut each piece of Cardstock listed in the measurements above.
- Fold Crumb Cake Cardstock in half to form card base.
- Adhere Misty Moonlight cardstock layer to the card base.
- Adhere Harvest Meadow DSP layer to the card base.
- Adhere Misty Moonlight cardstock square to the card base.
- Stamp abstract image onto Basic White cardstock *Stitched With Whimsy* square using Crumb Cake ink.
- Stamp chicory flower image overtop of the Crumb Cake abstract image using Misty Moonlight ink; adhere to the card base on top of the Misty Moonlight cardstock square.
- Die cut large chicory flowers from Crumb Cake and Misty Moonlight cardstocks and adhere to the card front to the left of the stamped image using Mini Dimensionals.
- Die cut sentiment label from Basic White cardstock. Stamp sentiment with Misty Moonlight ink, and adhere stamped label to the card front with Mini Dimensionals.
- Tie bow with Linen Thread and adhere to the card base at the flower stems and above the sentiment label with Mini Glue Dots.
- Embellish card front with three Brushed Metallic Dots.

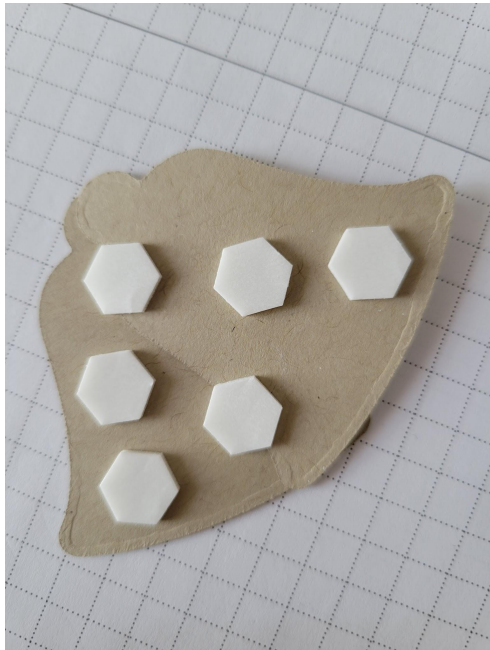

# Instructions

1. Adhere the Crumb Cake layer to the Pear Pizzazz layer using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
2. Stamp two of the bell images in Versamark Ink on the Crumb Cake cardstock. Cover in White Embossing Powder and tap off any excess. Heat emboss the bells using the Heat Tool.
3. Cut the bells out using the outline bell die from the Gingerbread dies and set them aside.
4. Stamp the sentiment in Versamark Ink on the strip of Basic Black cardstock. Heat emboss with White Stampin' Emboss Powder.
5. Run a thin line of Liquid Glue at the top of the Basic Black strip and glue to the bottom of the Heartwarming Hugs DSP. Now glue this to the front of the card, using Liquid Glue.
6. Arrange the bells to overlap as you want them on the front of the card. Use the dimensionals on the back to secure the placement.



7. Remove the backing from the Dimensionals and adhere the bells to the card.
8. Tie the Gingham Ribbon into a bow and adhere to the top of the bells using a Glue Dot.



9. Add the Elegant Faceted Embellishments.
10. Add the layer to the front of the card using Stampin Dimensionals.

# Instructions

1. Take a sheet of Cherry Cobbler Card and cut at 10.5cm before routing and scoring the card at 14.8cm. Cut a mat layer of Cherry Cobbler measuring 13.8cm by 9.5cm.
2. Die cut the solid snowflake shape twice out of Cinnamon Cider, Crumb Cake & Early Espresso. You will also want to die cut the ornate snowflake out of Basic White.
3. Using the coordinating ink, blend around the edges of the solid snowflake shapes to create a 3D effect.
4. Adhere the basic white elements to the coloured card.
5. Arrange on the mat layer with a combination of dimension. This will add additional interest to your project.
6. On a scrap piece of Cherry Cobbler Card, stamp your sentiment in Versamark Ink and heat set in gold. Fussy cut out and adhere to the card.
7. Splash some what over the card and sprinkle over gold embossing powder. Heat set.
8. Add Gilded Gems onto the card.

- Get a piece of Shaded Spruce cardstock
  - 20.5 x 29,7 cm or 8.1/16 x 11.11/16 inch
  - Score long side at 3, 17.5 and 20.5 cm or 1.3/16, 6.7/8 and 8.1/16 inch
  - Score short side at 3 and 17.5 cm or 1.3/16 and 6.7/8 inch
  - Cut out the squares in the middle as shown in the photo
  - Cut in the score lines as shown in the photo
  - Place Tear and tape on the flaps as shown in the photo



- Get of a piece of Designer series paper

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- Cut at 20.5 x 13 cm or 8.1/16 x 5.1/8 inch
- Score 3 sides at 3 and 17.5 cm or 1.3/16 and 6.7/8 inch
- Cut in the small score lines as shown in the photo
- Place Tear and tape as shown in photo

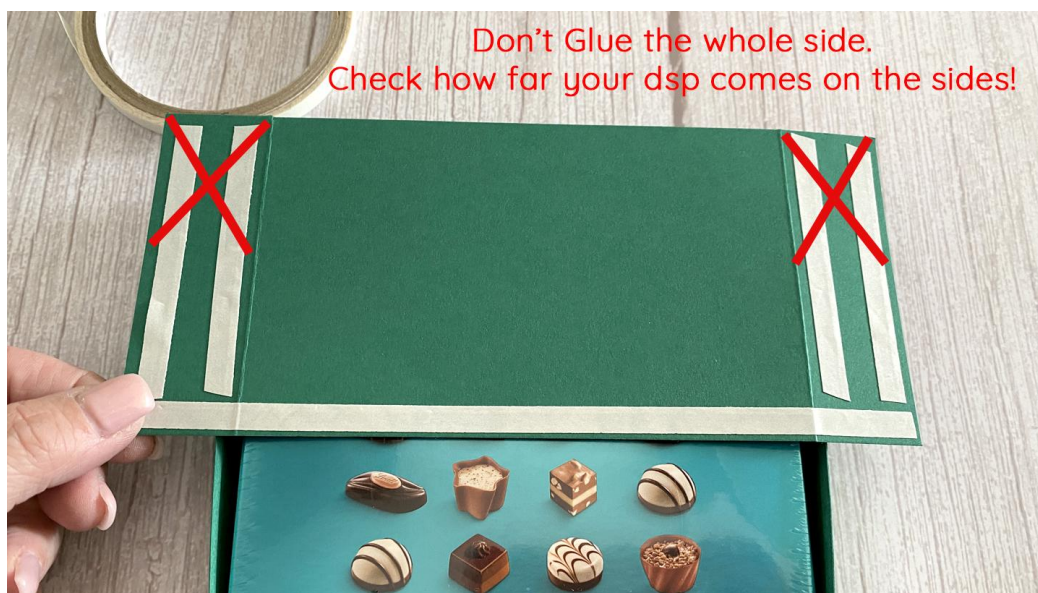


- Stick the two little flaps to the long side so the base of the box is formed. The shorter side will be on top now. We'll sort this out in a minute. No worries.

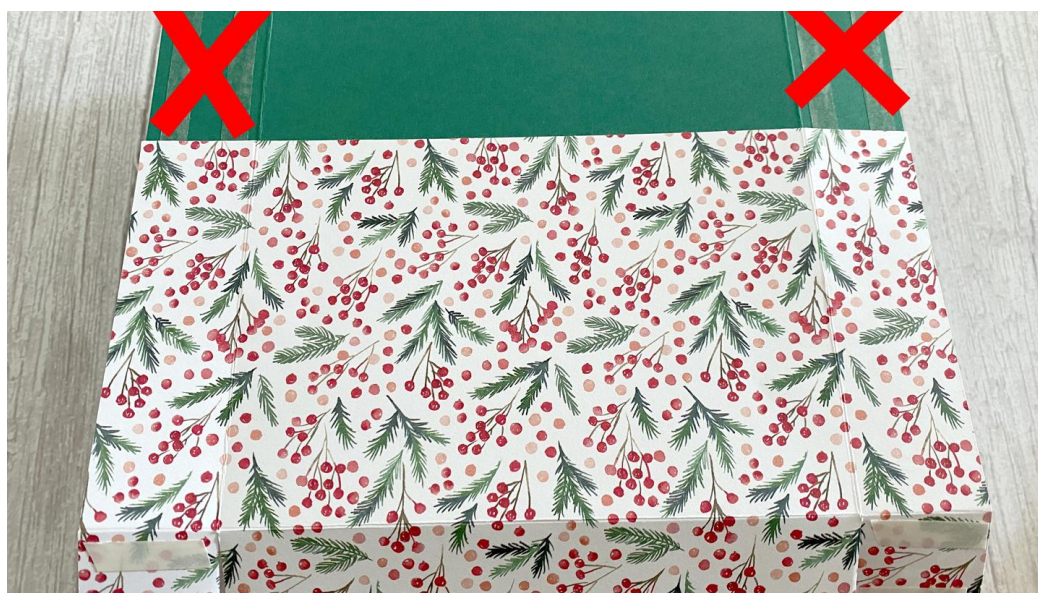


- Place tear and Tape on the other side of the dsp in the opposite side of where you made the cuts.





- Place Tear and Tape on the sides of the box, but not all the way to the end as I did in the photo. Check where the DSP will end. It will be more clear in the next photo.



- Before you Glue the dsp on the cardstock make sure you line out the score lines.
- First remove the Tear and tape off the cardstock
- Remove the Tear and tape off the other side of the dsp and stick it gently down at the top of the box like in the photo.
- Remove the tape on the front flaps and glue the box together.





- Remove the tape on the flaps and glue the box together. Turn the box around so the dsp is at the top.



- Place a ribbon around the box to close it completely



- Stamp a sentiment from the Christmas to remember stamp set and cut out with a label die from the Christmas Season bundle



- Decorate to your own taste. I used the Christmas Season bundle to make some leaves and berries.

- Card Base – Smoky Slate Cardstock
  - 11" x 5-1/2"

  - 3-3/4" x 3-3/4"
- Basic White Cardstock

- 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"
- Strip approximately 5" x 1-1/2" (for sentiment)
- Peaceful Place DSP - 2 pieces as follows:
  - Gingham piece is 5" x 5"
  - Speckled Foil piece is 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"

## Instructions

- Fold Smoky Slate Card Base in half and set aside
- Adhere the Gingham DSP to the larger black square and set aside
- Adhere speckled DSP to the smaller black square. Then use the Cut and Emboss Machine and the Cloche shape from the Cloche Dies to cut the shape out of the centre of the square, cutting through both layers in one pass
- Position the white panel behind the Black square. (The white is slightly smaller than the black) Stamp Village stamp through the hole with Basic Gray ink. (Make sure not to stamp it too low as that is where your sequins will go later) Then use the solid stamp with Pool Party ink to fill in the background behind the houses.
- Remove the top layer of adhesive around the front of the dome. Place dome through the hole you cut into the Black and Speckled square, and press to adhere it.
- Add adhesive (I used Multipurpose glue) to the back of the black square, and remove the adhesive strip on the back of the dome
- Place 2 large pinches of sequins onto the centre of the white panel, on top of the houses
- Then place the sticky black square over the centre of the white stamped panel, making sure not to disturb the sequins too much! Press well around the dome to ensure that sequins will not escape!
- Stamp the sentiment on your white strip and then use the long sentiment die in the Seasonal Labels dies to cut it out

- It's now time to assemble the card. Adhere larger Gingham/Black square to the Smoky Slate base
- Add dimensionals behind the smaller black and DSP square and place in the centre of the Gingham panel. I moved my square slightly higher to allow more room for my sentiment
- Add dimensionals behind the sentiment strip and add to the card just below the main domed square
- Tie a small bow with Pool Party sheer ribbon and attach with a glue dot just to the right of the sentiment
- Your card is done! Shake and Enjoy

1. Cut card base and fold and burnish score line.
2. Adhere the basic black and dsp layers to the front of the card.

4. Stamp and die cut the trees and pop up onto the front of the card
5. Stamp the cabin in Memento on scrap of Basic White card stock. Leaving enough room at the end of your piece to meet the bottom of the DSP. Pop up onto the front of the card. Wrap with ribbon and tie a bow.
6. Using Evening Evergreen die cut individual trees. Stamp with versamark and emboss with silver and adhere to the front or pop up onto the front of the card.
7. Emboss sentiment in silver and die cut with die from Snow Time Dies. Pop up onto the front of the card close to the top. Add rhinestone gems to each end of the sentiment die cut.
8. Rhinestones to 2 bottom corners.

## Inside of Card

1. Adhere Basic Black to the inside of the card.
2. Emboss snow along the top of the basic white layer on the inside of the card. Adhere.

# Instructions:

- Take scored card base and fold and burnish it with a bone folder
- Take Basic White piece and emboss with embossing folder then adhere to the card base front using glue
- Using a sponge dauber and Soft Suede Ink, distress the edges of each DSP strip. Then adhere to the embossed layer using Seal. I angled my pieces back and forth without measuring, but you can measure and place each one straight and even.

- Add the cork strip to the long white strip using Seal, then adhere the set to the card front using Dimensionals
- Using matching card stock and dies, I cut out the three long flowers, then I stamped and colored the sunflower, then I arranged and added each stem to the card front using glue. If a flower hung over and needed some support, I added a small Dimensional.
- Stamp the sentiment on Basic White Card Stock using Soft Succulent Ink then attach to the backing using Seal. Add a Dimensionals on the back at each end and a little glue in the middle and adhere at an angle to the card front.
- Add a bow and gems



## Inside

- Take the Basic White Insert and stamp and color the flowers on it
- Stamp the sentiment
- Add to the inside of the card base using Seal

- Add cork strip to the bottom

# Instructions:

- Fold your Very Vanilla card base in half. Burnish well with your bone folder for a nice, crisp fold.
- Run your Very Vanilla layer through your Cut & Emboss Machine, using the Timeword Type 3-D Embossing folder.
- Attach the Vanilla layer to the Blackberry Bliss layer then, using dimensionals, attach the Blackberry Bliss layer to your card base
- Using the leaf-wreath die from the Seasonal Swirls Dies, cut out a wreath in Blackberry Bliss, in Rich Razzleberry and in Gold Metallic.
- Waste not, want not! Use the centre-scrap of card stock that is left from cutting out each wreath to cut out loose leaves in each of the three colours. You will use these loose wreaths to embellish your card.

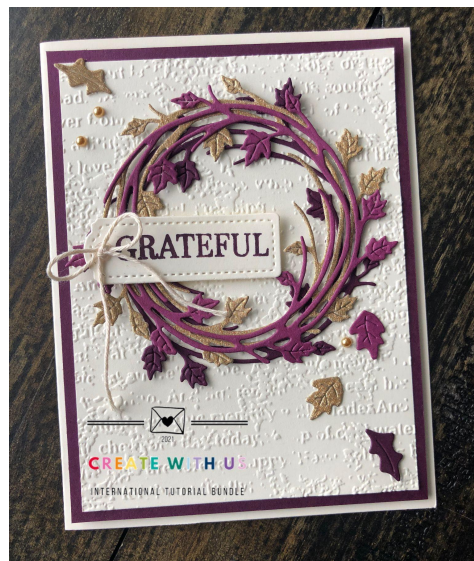


- Now we need to attach our wreaths:
  - Lay your Blackberry Bliss wreath on the card front
  - Lay your Gold Metallic wreath on top of the Blackberry wreath
  - Lay your Rich Razzleberry wreath on top of the other two wreaths.
  - To SECURE them add a small piece of Tear & Tape on the left hand side, where it will be covered by your sentiment. See photo below. (My apologies for the photo quality! Who knew Blackberry Bliss was so hard to photograph??).
  - Use 3 or 4 mini glue dots under the wreaths' leaves to add a bit more stability to the entire thing.





- Using a piece of Very Vanilla scrap, die cut the smallest tag from the Tailor Made Tags dies and stamp the “Grateful” sentiment, using Blackberry Bliss Classic ink.
- Attach the tag to the card front using dimensionals.
- Cut a piece of Vanilla Baker’s Twine approx 7” long (approx 18 cm). Tie in a bow and attach to the tag using a mini glue dot.
- Attach loose leaves to the card front using mini glue dots.
- Using your Take Your Pick tool, add gold metallic pearls to your card front.

The snowflake is already finished. You need to stamp and punch the deer by your one.



Assemble the trees, the deer and the sentiment on different levels with the liquid glue and dimensionals.

### **Card Base**

- Real Red, 11 X  $4\text{-}\frac{1}{4}$ , score at  $5\text{-}\frac{1}{2}$

### **Card Front**



- Basic White, 5 X 3-<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, emboss with the Timber EF. Layer on an additional piece of Basic White, 5-<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 3-<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>. Adhere to the card base.
- Basic White, 3 X 4-<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, stamp the image with Smoky Slate Ink. Color the image as shown with Real Red, Old Olive, and Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends Markers.
- Layer the image on a piece of Pear Pizzazz, 3-<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 4-<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>.
- Adhere the two pieces of Heartwarming Hugs to this panel as shown.
- Wrap a piece of ribbon around this panel and tie a bow. Adhere to the card front with Dimensionals.
- Basic White, ½ X 4-<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, stamp the sentiment with Pear Pizzazz Ink. Trim the ends and adhere to the card front as shown.
- Adhere several Red Rhinestones to the card front.

#### Inside of the Card



- Basic White, 5 X 3-<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, stamp the sentiment with Pear Pizzazz Ink. Next, stamp the image with Smoky Slate Ink and color with Stampin' Blends Markers. Layer on an additional piece of Basic White, 5-<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub> X 3-<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>. Adhere to the inside of the card.
