- First Basic White Piece
Un rectangle Blanc Simple
10,9 x 15 cm
- Second Basic White Piece
Un autre rectangle Blanc simple

1. Cut all the pieces. Glue the first Basic piece on the base card.

Découpez toutes les pièces de papier. Coller la première pièce sur la base de carte.

2. With the Picture This Dies, cut the circle die in the second Basic White piece and then emboss it with the embossing folder of your choice.

Avec les poinçons En Évidence, découpez les ronds dans le rectangle Blanc Simple de 10,6 x 12,5 cm puis embossez-le le plioir de votre choix.

3. Glue the DSP piece at the top of the card.

Collez le rectangle de papier imprimé en haut de votre carte.

4. Stamp and punch 2 penguins and 5 trees and place them behind the circles.

Tamponnez et percez 2 pingouins et 5 arbres et placez-les derrière les cercles.

5. Finish your card by placing a sentiment at the bottom.

Terminez votre carte en tamponnant un sentiment en bas.

IMPERIAL -

- Misty Moonlight
 - Card Base 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼" for a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card
- Basic White
 - Layer 1 - 4 ¼" x 5 ⅜"
 - Sentiment - ¾" x 2 ½"
- Balmy Blue
 - Embossed Layer - 3 ¼" x 5 ¼"
- Penguin Playmates Designer Series Paper
 - Multicolored Stripe - ¾" x 5 ¼"
 - Misty Moonlight Distressed Layer - 3" x 1 ¼"
- Glittered White Organdy Ribbon
 - Approximately 14"

METRIC -

- Misty Moonlight
 - Card Base 14cm x 21.5cm scored @ 10.8cm for a 10.8cm x 14cm card
- Basic White
 - Layer 1 - 10.8 cm x 13.6 cm
 - Sentiment - 2 cm x 6.3cm
- Balmy Blue
 - Embossed Layer - 8.25 cm x 13.3 cm
- Penguin Playmates Designer Series Paper
 - Multicolored Stripe- .6cm x 13.3cm
 - Misty Moonlight Distressed Layer- 7.6cm x 3.2cm
- Glittered White Organdy Ribbon
 - Approximately 35.5cm

Instructions

1. Emboss the Balmy Blue Layer with the snowflake image Embossing Folder from the Wintry 3D Embossing Folders Pack. Highlight a few raised areas with the White Chalk Pen.
2. Adhere the multicolored stripe Designer Series Paper to the Basic White layer, leaving a 1/8" border on the three sides. Adhere the Balmy Blue embossed layer to the Basic White layer, overlapping the Designer Series Paper as needed to create an even border.
3. Wrap White Glittered Ribbon around the two layers, tying on the left hand side.
4. Adhere the completed layers to the front of the card.
5. Distress the edges of the Misty Moonlight Designer Series Paper piece by running the edge of your Paper Snips along the edges of the paper.
6. Stamp the sentiment on the small piece of Basic White Cardstock with Just Jade Ink. Adhere to the back of the Misty Moonlight Designer Series Paper. And then adhere to the card.
7. Carefully cut out images from the Penguin Pals Designer Series Paper to use as the main accent on your card. Adhere them to the front of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Embellish with the Basic Rhinestone Jewels.

Measurements

METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)

- Card Base – thick Basic White cardstock 29.7 cm by 10.5 cm scored at 14.9 cm
 - Basic White cardstock 10 cm by 14.4 cm
 - Scraps of Basic White for sentiment. Extra Basic White strips 14.4cm long for tearing the “snow” at the base of the igloo.
 - White Velvet paper 7.5cm by 14.4cm

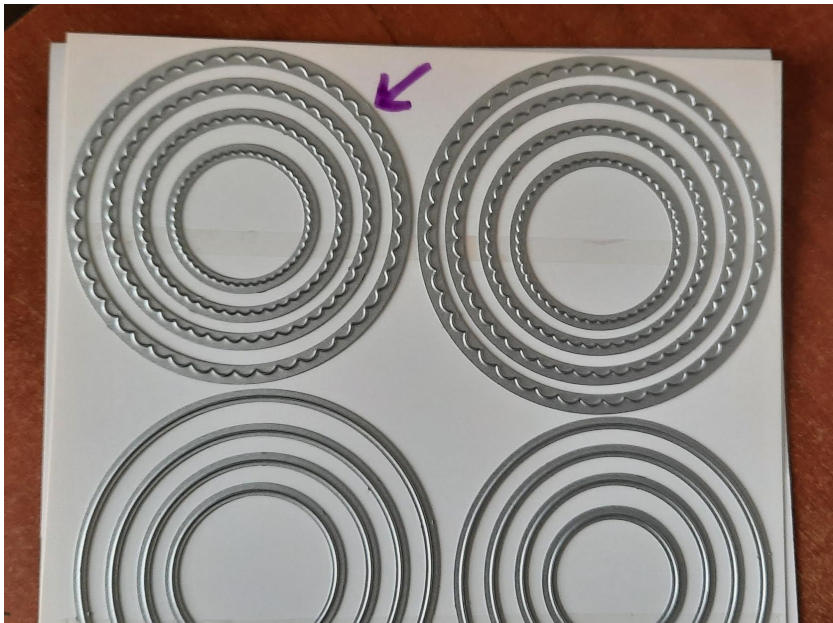
IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- Card Base – Basic White Thick Cardstock 11” by 4 ¼” scored at 5 ½”.
- Basic White Cardstock 4” by 5 ¼”.
- White Velvet paper 3” by 5 ¼”.

Instructions

1. Take your Basic White layer and use the snowflake stencil, your blending

- brush and Pool Party ink to make a snowflake background. Use the small snowflake stamp from Penguin Place to fill in the gaps. Adhere to card front.
2. Using the curved die from Basic Borders dies trim top long edge of your White Velvet piece. Run it through the Brick & Mortar embossing folder making sure the bricks are horizontal along the long edge.
 3. Using scalloped circle die cut a basic grey half circle, run through Bark 3D embossing folder and sponge with Basic Grey ink. (see photo for correct die size) This will be the shadow of the opening of the igloo.
 4. Fussy cut all your creatures from the Penguin Playmates paper and set aside.
 5. Stamp your sentiment in Memento black on a scrap of Basic White. Trim. Cut a narrow strip of Be Dazzling paper and adhere to back of sentiment using Tear'n'Tape or liquid glue.
 6. Adhere your white velvet igloo to the card front. It's ok if it doesn't quite reach to the bottom of the card. Put the scalloped circle in the middle trimming it to the size that you want.
 7. Tear your strips of basic white cardstock to make your snow. Put wink of stella along the torn edge. This will not only add sparkle, it will also give your snow a light grey tinge.
 8. Adhere the strips to the bottom of your card putting adhesive only along the bottom edge. This will allow you to tuck your creatures in between the layers.
 9. Add your creatures as shown or get creative and make your own penguin party.
 10. Add your sentiment with dimensionals.
 11. Finish your card with some elegant faceted gems.
 12. In the inside of your card, use the snowflake mask to make a snowflake pattern along the right edge. Punch out two penguins from the Penguin Playmates paper and fussy cut a sleeping fox. Stamp a greeting in Memento Black.

METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)

- Card Base – Pool Party
 - 10.5 cm x 14.8 cm
- Mat Layer – Pool Party & Vellum
 - 9.5 cm x 13.8 cm

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- Card Base – Pool Party
 - 4.1" x 5.8"
- Mat Layer – Pool Party & Vellum
 - 3.7" x 5.4"

Instructions

1. Take a sheet of Pool Party Card and cut at 10.5cm before routing and scoring the card at 14.8cm. Cut two matted layers of Pool Party & Vellum measuring 13.8cm by 9.5cm.
2. On the Pool Party layer, stamp the small circle that is in the stamp randomly in Pool Party Ink. Once complete adhere the Vellum behind on a slight angle before adhering to you card base.
3. Using the Stitched So Sweetly Dies to die cut one of the scallop rectangles. I cut a rectangle just slightly smaller than the stitched line. Before attaching the die cut element, I cut a length of white ribbon from the flowers for every season ribbon pack and attached it with a staple. Attach this to the card.
4. I stamped the tree in Granny Apple, the present in Melon Mambo & the stars in Daffodil Delight. I fussy cut these out and attached on the die cut shape.
5. Stamp the sentiment in Versamark and sprinkle over white embossing powder. Heat set. I always cut the sentiment down after lining the sentiment up with the edge of the blade runner. I cut the 'Be Cool, Be Chilly, Be Merry' into three section and attached to the card.

Measurements

- Basic White Cardstock
 - Scrap from which to cut penguin body, trees, hat, scarf and curved circle base (approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ sheet of cardstock will suffice)
- Basic Black Cardstock
 - Scrap from which to punch Penguin body
- Painted Christmas DSP
 - Scrap from which to diecut tag shape from the Stockings dies
 - Scrap from which to diecut circle from the Layering Circles dies
- Cork Specialty paper
 - Strip approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide to place across bottom of tag

Instructions

- Fold Kraft Gift box on all score lines. BEFORE assembling box, stamp greeting in bottom right-hand corner of box. Peel backing off adhesive strips and assemble box and set aside
- Die cut the tag shape from the Painted Christmas DSP. Adhere strip of cork paper to the bottom of the tag and cut off ends in line with tag
- Cut Circle from red DSP

- Stamp curved slop stamp on White cardstock with black ink. Use scissors to cut just above the curved line, and then die cut with same circle shape:



- Position the white curve on Red DSP circle and adhere:



- Punch larger penguin shape from Black cardstock and smaller penguin shape from White cardstock. Adhere together. Stamp eyes in black ink (or alternatively glue googly eyes if preferred). Stamp nose in Petal Pink.
- On White cardstock scrap stamp the following: Trees in Soft Succulent and Garden green, hat in Balmy Blue, Scarf in Misty Moonlight. Cut around each shape with scissors
- Using dimensionals, adhere penguin in front of the white slope, and then also with dimensionals, add hat and trees. Attach scarf with glue dots.

- Use Detailed Trio punch to make 2 holes at top of tag. Thread red ribbon through the tag holes and tie around the gift box. Tie at the top with a bow.
- Fill box with gifts of your choice and give to someone you love!

Instructions

1). Adhere Basic White middle layers in correct sections - see photographs below:



2). Adhere Beauty of the Earth in correct sections - see photographs above

- 3). Emboss the two Silver Foil pieces using the Tasteful Texture 3D Embossing Folder and adhere in correct sections - see top photograph.
- 4). Using the Penguin Builder Punch, put a 2" (5cm) wide piece of Black Glitter Paper into the punch so you can see the white backing and punch out 3 penguin bodies.
- 5). Using the Penguin Builder punch, put a 1¾" (4.5cm) wide piece of Snowy White Velvet Paper into the punch so you can see the white backing and punch out 3 penguin body fronts.
- 6). Take a scrap of Snowy White Velvet Paper that is big enough to punch out 7 feet using the Penguin Builder Punch. Colour this scrap using the pen tip of the Dark Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blend and punch out the feet.



- 7). Take a scrap of Black Glitter Paper and punch out seven eyes using any punch you have that punches out small dots. NOTE: I used the Label Me Fancy Punch. You could use the Turtle Punch, the Whale Punch, the Deer Builder Punch, the Happy Holly-days Punch, or the Detailed Trio Punch.

8). Use the penguin beak stamp from the Penguin Place Stamp Set together with Pumpkin Pie Ink and carefully stamp a beak on each of the 3 Snowy White Velvet Paper penguin body fronts. NOTE: before I stamped on the body fronts, I tested the stamp first to see how much pressure it needed to stamp a perfect image. After I had tried it on scrap paper, I stamped onto some scraps of the Snowy White Velvet Paper. When I was happy, I stamped on the actual body fronts.

9). Use Mini Glue Dots to adhere 2 feet to each body front and to adhere the body front to the Black Glitter Paper body.

10). Adhere two eyes to each body front using Tombow Glue.

11). To make the penguin that's sliding on his tummy, ink the stamp with Misty Moonlight Ink and stamp it on the back of a piece of Black Glitter Paper. NOTE: take care when stamping because it will be very slippery! Concentrate when stamping so you stop it from sliding. Blot the image dry using some kitchen towel and then cut out the whole image.



12). To make the body front for the penguin that's sliding on his tummy, ink the stamp with Misty Moonlight Ink and stamp it on the back of a piece of Snowy White Velvet Paper. NOTE: take care when stamping because it will

be very slippery! Concentrate when stamping so you stop it from sliding. Blot the image dry using some kitchen towel. Carefully cut around the lower part of the image, i.e. the part that is NOT solid ink.

13). Use Mini Glue dots to adhere the body front onto the Black Glitter Paper body.

14). Use the other beak stamp with Pumpkin Pie Ink and stamp onto a scrap of Snowy White Velvet Paper. Next fussy cut the beak!

15). Adhere one foot to the penguin using a Mini Glue Dot, then adhere one eye and the beak using Tombow Glue.

16). Take two pieces of Snowy White Velvet Paper that are the same width as the Beauty of the Earth Designer Series Paper which is on the largest panel inside the card. Make one piece that is taller than the other. Tear both pieces so the top piece is coming towards you and create snow mounds.

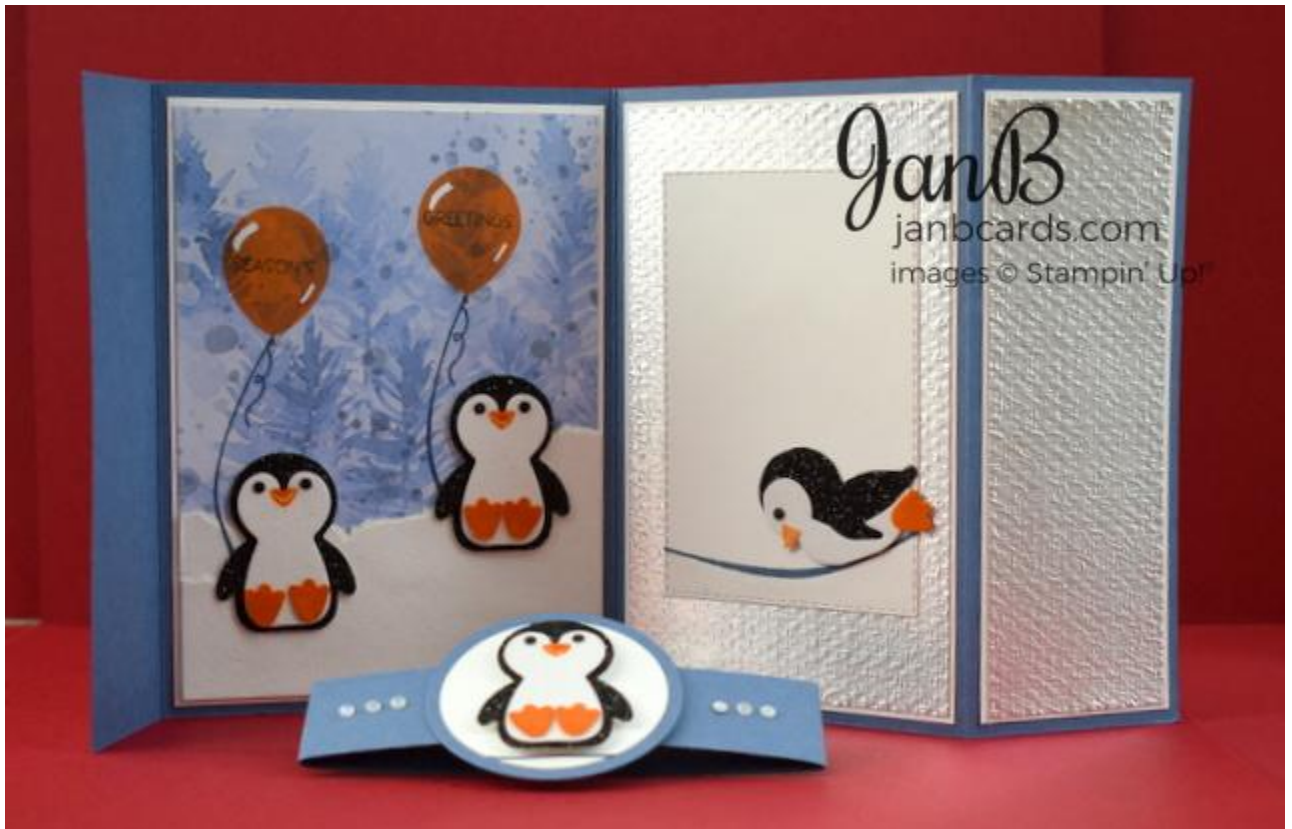
17). Using Tombow Glue, adhere both pieces to line up at the bottom of the Designer Series Paper so that both mounds are visible.

18). Ink the balloon stamp up with Pumpkin Pie Ink and stamp above where the two penguins will be positioned. NOTE: I didn't adhere my penguins until after I had painted the balloons, string and sentiments. Also, I wasn't worried that the Designer Series Paper is visible through the balloons because not all balloons are solid colours!

19). Put your first penguin where you intend to glue him and see where you need to stamp the string. Use Misty Moonlight Ink for the string. Do the same for the second penguin. NOTE: make sure both pieces of string will end up just behind their wings! If you need to stamp on part of the Snowy White Velvet Paper mound like I have, cover most of the Designer Series Paper with a scrap of paper before aligning your stamp up to continue with the piece of string already stamped.

20). The sentiment SEASON'S GREETINGS is on one stamp, one word above the other. I cut my stamp in half. If you're not happy to do that, mask

half of the stamp while you stamp one word. Then clean your stamp, mask the other half and stamp the second word.



21). Adhere the two penguins in place using Mini Glue Dots.

22). Die-cut a rectangle of Basic White Cardstock using the no.5 regular size Stitched Rectangle Die.

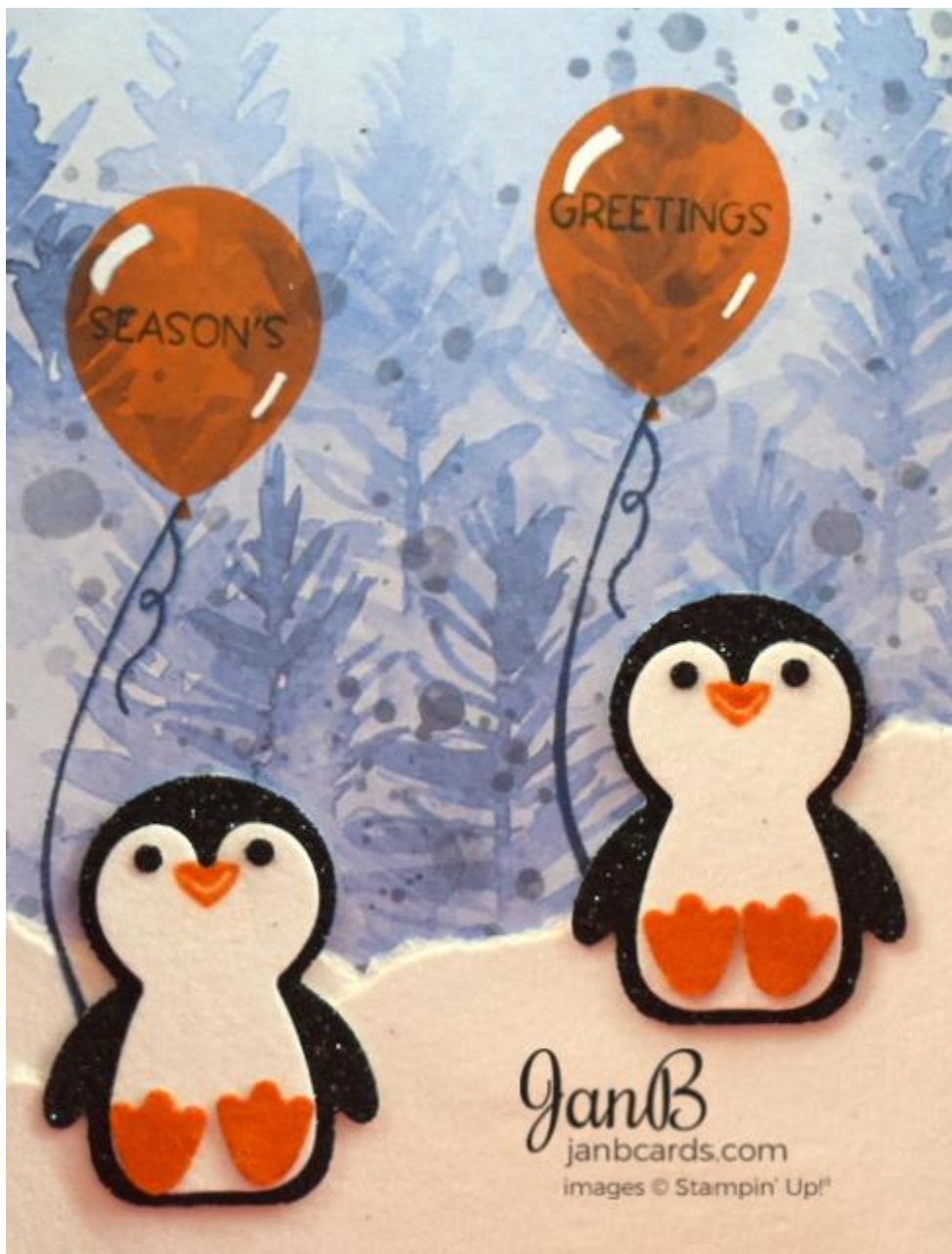
23). Using the long thin line (horizon) stamp and Misty Moonlight Ink, stamp a line on this die-cut so you can adhere the penguin on it so he looks as if he is sliding along it. NOTE: the rest of this die-cut is for another sentiment or for a written greeting.

24). Adhere the penguin in place using Tombow Glue.

25). To create the belly band, wrap the 1" (2.5cm) strip of Misty Moonlight Cardstock around the closed card and gently squeeze on both sides where score lines need to be.

26). Use trimmer to score fold lines on the belly band - score lines look a lot neater than fold lines.

27). Overlap the two ends of the belly band and put a small strip of Tear & Tape vertically on the inside of the top flap and on the top of the underneath part of the flap. Remove both pieces of the tape backing and adhere together without pulling the sides together tightly - allow room for the belly band to be moved up and down.



28). Die-cut a Basic White Cardstock circle using the no. 5 straight cut circle from the Layering Circles Dies and a Misty Moonlight Cardstock circle using the no.6 straight cut die.

29). Using the long thin line (horizon) stamp and Misty Moonlight Ink, stamp a line on the white die-cut circle along the bottom for the penguin to stand on. Paint the area beneath the line using the Clear Wink of Stella Glitter Pen.

30). Adhere the white circle onto the blue circle. Next adhere the circles on the belly band to cover the join. Adhere the penguin using Dimensionals.

31). Finally, decorate the Designer Series Paper that is visible when the card is closed and the belly band is on, with Subtle Shimmer Sequins. I used large silver sequins. I also adhered two lines of three small opaque sequins either side of the penguin on the belly band.

 - 10.2 x 14 cm - cut an angle into two pieces
- **Basic White cardstock**
 - one piece to die cut the Scalloped Contour die
 - one scrap piece to stamp on and to cut out 2 pieces with the penguin punch
- **Basic Black Cardstock**
 - one scrap piece to cut out 2 pieces with the penguin punch

Measurements

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- **Basic White Thick Cardstock - card**
 - 4 x 5.1/2"
- **Penguin Playmates DSP**
 - 4 x 5.1/2" - cut at an angle into two pieces
- **Basic White cardstock**
 - one piece to die cut the Scalloped Contour die
 - one scrap piece to stamp on and to cut out 2 pieces with the penguin punch
- **Basic Black Cardstock**
 - one scrap piece to cut out 2 pieces with the penguin punch

Instructions



- Cut out the Scalloped contour die with a piece of Basic white cardstock
- Use a Blending brush to apply some Pool Party ink in the middle. Don't use pressure on the brush. It's better to do a gentle touch and apply several layers, if you want to avoid stains (see photo).



- Stamp the little Christmas Tree on the sponged background. Each tree I stamped off 2 times at an angle. Stamp the snowflakes in Pool

Party. I stamped full color, but you could also try to stamp off first for a more subtle look.



- Punch out two black parts of the penguin and two white parts.
- Stamp the eyes on the white parts with Memento black ink and the nose and feet with Petal Pink ink (you also could choose another color like Pumpkin Pie for this). Don't glue it all together yet. I'd like to do all the gluing in the end.



- Stamp the scarf and cap in colors of your choosing. I used Fresh Freesia and Misty Moonlight as I liked that combination with the designer series paper I used. I like to stamp multiple times so I can

choose the best ones to cut out.



- Cut out two scarfs and two caps with paper snips scissors



- Cut a piece of designer series paper measuring 4 x 5.½"
- Cut this piece down the middle at an angle like in the photo. I didn't measure, just eyeballed it by placing my paper at an angle in my trimmer.



- Glue down one piece of designer paper onto your card (the 2nd piece you can use for a 2nd card) .
- Use dimensionals to glue the scalloped contour die piece onto the card
- Glue the penguin parts together, use dimensionals to glue them onto the card



- Cut off a small piece of ribbon, fold down the middle.



- Use a glue dot at the end to hold it together.



- Use a glue dot and a paper piercer or your Take a pick tool to place the ribbon between the scalloped piece and the card.



- Make a silver bow and use half a glue dot to place it onto the card in the middle of the ribbon



- Voilà, your card is finished!

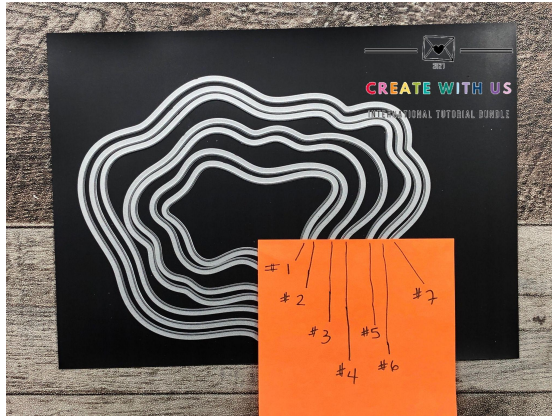

 - 14.9 cm x 21 cm
- Layers:
 - Black 14.6 cm x 10.2 cm
 - Freesia 14.3 cm x 9.9 cm
 - White 14.3 cm x 9.9 cm
- Scraps: Black Glitter & White

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock)

- Card Base – White Thick
 - 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"
- Layers:
 - Black 5 1/4" x 4"
 - Freesia 5" x 3 3/4"
 - White 5" x 3 3/4"
- Scraps: Glitter & White

Instructions:

- Fold your Basic White Thick card base in half. For this project using the Thick card stock for the base is best, as the front has several layers and we want it to be sturdy. Burnish well with your bone folder for a nice, crisp fold.
- **First we need to prepare our layers:**



- Using Diorama Die #5 (the 3rd largest) in the photo above, cut a hole in your Basic White layer.
- Using Diorama Die #3 (the third smallest) in the photo above, cut a hole in your Freesia layer.
 - ** for my project I used the Penguin Playmate Designer Paper that is free during the Aug/Sept 2021 Sale-a-bration promotion. If you don't have this paper you can create your own by simply using Fresh Freesia card stock and randomly stamping the snowflake image (that is in the stamp set) all over your layer.
- Using Diorama Die #2 (the second smallest) in the photo above, cut a hole in your Black Glitter paper
- You will now have your card base and three layers with holes in them:



- Don't adhere your layers yet, but lay them on top of each other so you can stamp the Gorgeous Grape sentiment through the holes, onto the Basic White card base.



- Using your Gorgeous Grape and Fresh Freesia inks, randomly stamp snowflakes around the Basic White layer.
- **Next we need to attach make our little penguins:**
 - Using your Penguin Builder Punch, punch out the penguin shape from your Black Glitter Paper
 - Using your Penguin Builder Punch, punch out the penguin CENTRE from your Basic White card stock (OR you can use your paper snips to “fussy cut” the body shape from one of the penguins in the Penguin Playmates Designer Paper) *see pictures 1 & 2 below
 - To make the face on your Basic White Penguin, stamp the eyes using Memento Black Ink and stamp the beak and feet using Flirty Flamingo Ink. * see picture 3 below.



- Stamp two scarves using Gorgeous Grape Ink and one scarf using Fresh Freesia Ink. Cut out with your Paper Snips. If you need more definition on the scarves, use your Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker to outline where the scarf lines intersect. *see photo below

- **Now we assemble:**

- Attach the Black Glitter layer to your card base. I used Stampin' Seal. Don't put adhesive close to the cut out edge of your hole. You will want room to tuck your little penguin under the layer.
- Attach the Fressia layer to the Black Glitter layer using dimensionals. *Be liberal with the dimensionals - you want the card to be sturdy.*
- Attach the Basic White layer to the Freeia layer using more dimensionals. Again, be liberal! As before, don't place the dimensionals too close to the cut hole edges. You need to tuck one of the penguins in the right hand area and you need to tuck the snowflakes in the top right hand and bottom left hand areas. If your dimensionals are too close to the edges you won't have room to attach these pieces.
- Cut two of the Wonderful Snowflakes so they will be able to fit under the top layer of your card. I cut about $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ off each snowflake. Attach a glue dot to the snowflake center and adhere it to your card.
- Attach white bodies of the penguins to the Black Glitter outlines using mini glue dots.
- Attach the three penguins to the card using the adhesive of your choice. The two on the right hand side are tucked under layers. The one on the left hand side is on top of the layers.



Ta-Da! Done! There are lots of steps to this project but it's worth it. SO CUTE! Enjoy the tutorial. If you have any questions please ask!

- Basic White Thick Cardstock
 - 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{5}{8}$ "
- Basic White Thick Cardstock for sentiments of your choice, Circle Die Cut and front of penguins body

- Fresh Freesia DSP
 - 4.5" x 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ "
- Misty Moonlight DSP
 - 3 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ "
- Just Jade DSP
 - 4" x 1"
- Misty Moonlight Cardstock strip to tear - 8cm

Instructions

1. Score the Thick Basic White Cardstock at 14.75cm
2. Punch out Basic Black Cardstock for the penguin body and feet. Punch Basic White Cardstock for the front of the body.
3. Stamp the eyes in Black Memento Ink and the beak in Calypso Coral Ink. I have fussy cut the beak out and adhered it, but you can stamp this directly on to the cardstock.
4. Adhere the Fresh Freesia Designer Series Paper on an angle to the Basic White Cardstock. Then adhere the Misty Moonlight DSP on an angle also.
5. Take a length of White Crinkled Seam Binding and adhere behind the Just Jade DSP. Then take the piece of Just Jade DSP and layer over the two pieces of DSP. I had a piece of Misty Moonlight Cardstock sitting on my desk, so I tore one side and added this under the Just Jade DSP.
6. Cut a Basic White Circle, or even a square piece, add some Dimensionals to the back of the circle and place over the ribbon.
7. Stamp three trees in Just Jade Ink and fussy cut out. Place Dimensionals behind them and layer them on your card as desired.
8. Stamp a sentiment and raise it up with Dimensionals.
9. Because I like embellishments, I tied a White Crinkled Seam Binding bow and adhered it with a glue dot near the circle. I placed Glue Dots under the ends of the crossed ends of the ribbon to keep them in place.

10. Three Basic Rhinestones were added in a triangle for the final details.

Instructions:

- Take scored card base and fold and burnish it with a bone folder

- Take the Soft Sea Foam layer and adhere it to the card front using Seal
- Take the DSP layer and adhere it to the Soft Sea Foam layer using Seal
- Corners - from the point of the corner of a piece of card stock, measure out two inches down each side and mark with a tic mark. Then place in your trimmer and line the two tick marks in the cutting well and then slice. Do all four corners this way. Then glue in the corners of the card front.
- On the Basic White rectangle piece, stamp the penguin using the Tuxedo Black ink and stamp a nose using the Mango Melody. Stamp and Fussy cut a hat and scarf from Fresh Freesia ink. Punch feet out from Mango Melody card stock. Add all pieces to the penguin using glue
- Glue the Basic White and the Just Jade rectangles together and attach to the card front using Dimensionals
- Stamp the Merry Christmas sentiment onto the Basic White sentiment label using Misty Moonlight Ink, then glue the Basic White label to the Misty Moonlight back. Put a Dimensional at each end of this piece and a little glue in between and attach going across the penguin piece.
- Add gems and a bow





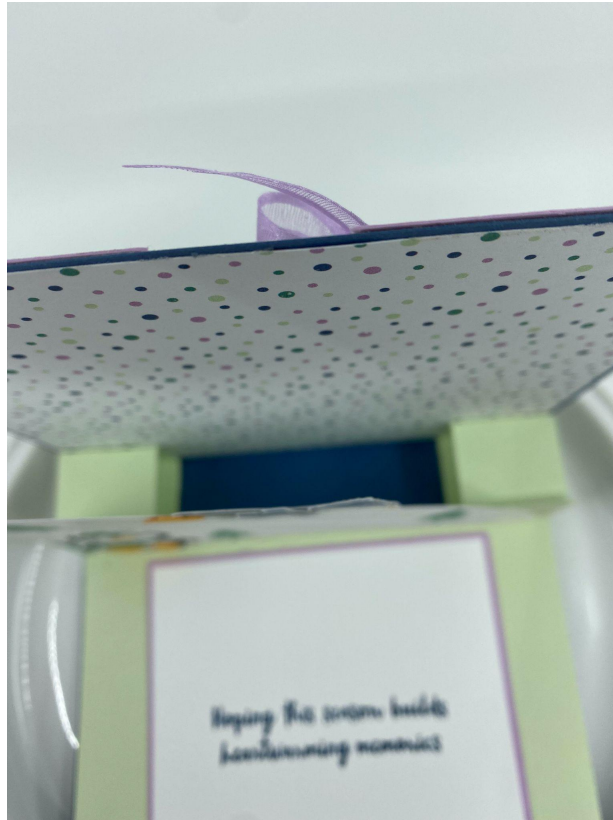
Inside: 3D

- Take the inside top piece of DSP and add to the inside of the card base
- Take the two cube strips and fold and burnish each score mark. Fold around and glue together with the smaller tab to the inside. Glue the bottom down to the inside of the card base. Make sure each cube is glued next to the edge and right up against the score mark of the card base. The bottom of the cube is glued to the inside bottom of the card base.
- Take the Soft Sea Foam inside bottom piece and fold up at the score mark. Put glue on the back of the Soft Sea Foam piece and on the front of the

cubes. Next lay the Soft Sea Foam piece on top of the inside bottom and line it all up and glue the tab section to the front of the cubes.

- Glue the inside top to the back side of the cubes. This makes the card pop out and fold back flat.
- Take the Basic White piece that's for the snow slope and a pair of scissors and just free hand cut it to look like a rolling hillside. Take the scenery stamp and Balmy Blue ink and stamp onto the snow slope. Add some trees in random places.
- On a scrap piece of Basic White, stamp the penguins and all the pieces needed and either fussy cut some and use the punch on others. Glue all the pieces together and add to the slope. Glue the slope to the Soft Sea Foam tab that's glued to the cubes
- Stamp the sentiment of the Basic White inside piece and then glue it to the Fresh Freesia back then add to the bottom section of the inside of the card base using Seal.
- Add the DSP strip to the bottom

The section back behind the ski slope can hold a gift card or money:

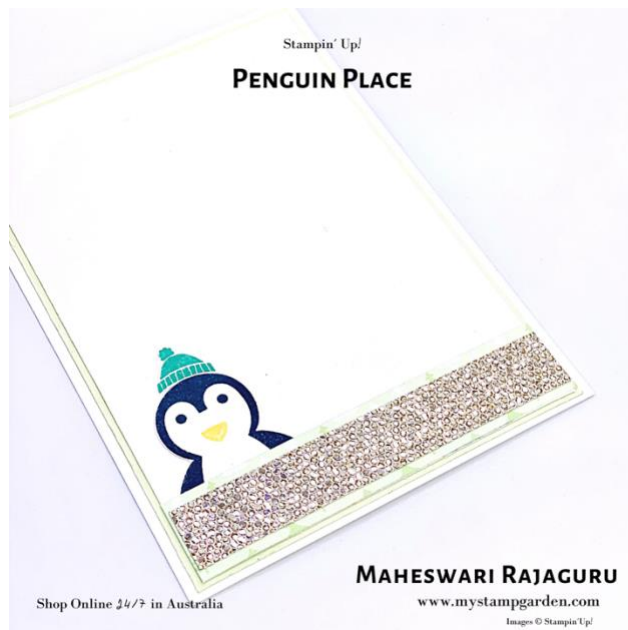

- Layer 1: Soft Seafoam
 - 10cm x 14.4 cm (2 Pieces- 1 for inside)
- Layer 2: Penguin Playmates – Designer Series Paper (DSP)
 - 9.8 cm x 14.2 cm
- Basic White
 - Layer 3- 10cm by 3 cm (embossed - Checks & Dots EF – bottom piece)
 - 9.7 cm by 14.1 cm (Inside)
 - Extra piece for Punching, Stamping and Die-cutting
- Just Jade – Scrap Piece – 1.5cm by 9 cm (behind the dies)
- So Saffron – Scrap Piece – 1.5cm by 8.5 cm (behind the dies)

Instructions

1. Create the card base by folding it on the scored line.
2. Adhere layer 1 - Soft Seafoam to the Layer 2 - DSP, and then adhere it to the base card- Thick Basic White.
3. Stamp the image using Memento Tuxedo Basic Black Ink for the penguin body, Scarf and head in Just Jade, Legs and Nose in So Saffron. Punch out and fussy cut all the pieces. I used Just Jade Dark Stampin' Blends – on the edges of the Scarf and for the headpiece and I used So Saffron Dark Stampin' Blends for the legs and nose part to give little dark shades.
4. Emboss the Layer 3 – Basic White Cardstock using the Check & Dots embossing folder and attached it to the bottom of the layer 2- DSP.
5. Stamp the sentiment on Basic White Cardstock using Memento Tuxedo Black ink.
6. Circles are Die-Cut using Be -Dazzling 6 by 6 Speciality Sale- A -Bration DSP and basic white cardstocks using Layering Circle Dies.
7. Stamped the snowflakes and sponged the So Saffron Stampin' Classic Ink on top of the Basic White Circle die-cut piece.
8. Adhere the delicate snowflakes on the top of the basic white circle dies using glue and attached the punched pieces using Stampin' Dimensional.
9. Tie a double bow using Just Jade and White Crinkled Ribbon (cut the ribbon into half) and adhere to the bottom left-hand side of the circle die.
10. As a final touch added Rhinestones, some Clear Wink of Stella on top of the penguin to add slight Shimmer to it, then splattered some Just Jade ink on the background using Stampin' write markers.

Inside of the card

1. First, adhere to the Soft Seafoam followed by the next layer as Basic White for writing.
2. Adhere half of the penguin to the bottom and a small decoration piece of the Designer Series Paper.

Measurements

METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)

- Coastal Cabana
 - Card Base
 - 14.1cm x 9.7cm x 1 pieces
- Bermuda Bay
 - 14.3 x 9.9cm x 2 pieces
- Basic White
 - 14.1cm x 9.7cm x 1 pieces
- Basic Black, Mango Melody, Coastal Cabana & Basic White
 - Scrap pieces for sentiment and penguin & punch
- Ombre 12x12 Specialty Paper
 - 2.5cm x 14.1cm x 1 piece
 - 2.5cm x 9.7cm x 1 piece

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- Coastal Cabana
 - Card Base
 - 4" x 5 1/4" x 1 pieces
- Bermuda Bay
 - 4" x 5 1/4 x 2 pieces
- Basic White
 - 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" x 1 pieces
- Basic Black, Mango Melody, Coastal Cabana & Basic White
 - Scrap pieces for sentiment and penguin & punch
- Ombre 12x12 Specialty Paper
 - 1" x 5 1/8" x 1 piece
 - 1" x 3 7/8" x 1 piece

Instructions

1. Take a smaller layer of Coastal Cabana and repeatedly stamp the balloon image from the Penguin Place stamp set over the background in Coastal Cabana Ink. Spritz the top right and bottom right corner of this piece with water from a Stampin' Spritzer to soften the fibres of the cardstock and using a bone folder rub the corners of the cardstock repeatedly to distress the corners of the cardstock. Adhere the larger strip of Ombre Specialty Paper to the left-hand side and wrap two layers of Linen Thread and tie a bow. Adhere this piece to a layer of Bermuda Bay with Liquid Adhesive. Roll the distressed corner and staple. Adhere this layer to the card base with Stampin' Dimensionals.
2. Punch a label once from Coastal Cabana and Basic White using the Label Me Lovely Punch. Adhere together slightly off centred and adhere where shown with Stampin' Dimensionals.
3. Punch the Penguin using the Penguin Builder Punch from a mixture of Basic Black, Basic White and Mango Melody. Adhere together. Stamp the eyes using Memento Black from the Penguin Place Stamp. Stamp the beak in Mango Melody and stamp a scarf from a scrap of Basic White in Polished Pink, fussy cut and adhere to penguin using small Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the penguin to the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
4. Stamp a sentiment on some Basic Black cardstock with Versamark and heat emboss with white. Trim into a thin strip and adhere to the card with a mixture of Liquid Glue and Stampin' Dimensionals. Embellish with some spritzes of Wink of Stella and some Blue Adhesive Backed Gems around the sentiment.
5. To decorate the inside of the card, stamp some of the small presents from the Penguin Place stamp set in Polished Pink and a "Happy Birthday" sentiment in Memento Black. Add the smaller strip of Ombre Specialty Paper to the bottom and adhere to a layer of Bermuda Bay. Add to the card insert. Enjoy!

Measurements

METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)

- Ombre Gift Bag – Fresh Freesia
- Penguin Playmates DSP
 - 4 cm x 25.5 cm
 - Fussy cut Polar Bear image

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- Ombre Gift Bag – Fresh Freesia
- Penguin Playmates DSP
 - 1 ½" x 10" striped pattern
 - Fussy cut Polar Bear image

Instructions

- Apply adhesive to the length of Penguin Playmates DSP; wrap around the gift bag and secure the ends at the back seam.
- Adhere Snowflake embellishment to the front of the Gift Bag with a Mini Glue Dot.
- Fussy cut Polar Bear image and adhere to the Gift Bag with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Stamp sentiment below the Polar Bear using Misty Moonlight ink.
- Embellish front of the Gift Bag with three Basic Rhinestone Jewels.
- Tie Fresh Freesia Ribbon (63 cm / 25") around chocolate bar securing in a bow at one end; insert into the Gift Bag.

Measurements

IMPERIAL - (For letter size cardstock only)

- Card Base –Basic White
 - 11" x 4 1/4" score at 5 1/2"
- Real Red
 - 5 3/8 x 4 1/8" for the inside of the card
 - 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" inside of card (matte of the Basic White)
 - Triangle for the front (once the base is folded use that area for the template.
 - 4 1/8" x 2 1/8" (for the top section on the front)
 - 4 1/8" x 1" (for the 2nd section on the front of the card)
 - Punch Scalloped Oval
- DSP
 - 5 1/4" x 4 (for the inside of the card)
 - 4" x 2 (for the top section on the front)
 - 4" x 7/8" (for the 2nd section on the front)
 - Triangle for the tip on the front
 - Fussy cut polar bear
- Basic White
 - 3 1/8" x 3 1/8" for the inside of the card
 - Punch small oval for sentiment
 - punch belly portion of penguin
- ☺ Basic Black punch penguin body
- ☺ Daffodil Delight punch penguin feet

METRIC - (For A4 cardstock only)

- Card Base – Basic White
 - 27.9 cm x 10.9 cm score at 14 cm
- Real Red
 - 13.7 cm x 10.5 cm for the inside of the card
 - 8.3 cm x 8.3 cm for the matte layer to the basic white inside of card
 - 10.1 cm x 5.4 cm top section front of the card
 - 10.1 cm x 2.6 cm 2nd section on the front
 - Punch scallop oval
 - Triangle for the front
- DSP
 - 13.6 cm x 10.1 cm for the inside of the card
 - 10.5 cm x 5.2 cm for the top front of card
 - 10.5 cm x 2.3 cm for the second section on the front
 - Triangle for the front
 - Fussy cut polar bear
- Basic White
 - 8 cm x 8 cm for the inside of the card
 - Punch small oval for the sentiment
 - punch belly portion of the penguin
- Basic Black & Daffodil Delight punch body and feet of penguin

Instructions

1. Cut card base and fold and burnish score line. Score another line at 3 ¼".
2. Mark edge at where the card opens at the ½ way mark. (2 ⅛") Measure up from each corner at the opening and mark at 2 ⅛". Score from mark to mark and fold up to create the pocket. Add real red and dsp to the triangle section. Once you fold up on the score lines you can use that section as a template. Cut real red and dsp and add to the triangle.
3. Adhere the Real Red piece to the top of the front. Adhere the dsp to the layer. (4 ⅛ x 2 ⅛ & 4 x 2)
4. Adhere Real Red and DSP to the section between the triangle and the score line. (4 ⅛ x 1 & 4 x ⅞)
5. Adhere snowflake to the 2 ⅛ section of the front. Do not add adhesive to the top of the snowflake.
6. Add the polar bear to the center front of the card tucking into the pocket a bit.
7. After punching and assembling the penguin, pop up on the triangle.
8. Pop up the scallop oval to the right of the penguin.
9. Stamp sentiment on the white oval in Real Red and adhere to the scallop oval.
10. Add red rhinestone to the right of the sentiment and to the corner of the triangle.
11. Tie bow and adhere between the sentiment and the penguin.

Inside of Card

1. Adhere Real Red to the inside of the card.
2. Adhere the dsp to the Real Red Layer
3. Adhere 3 ¼" square to the inside of the card
4. Stamp off snowflakes in Real Red across the bottom and in the two bottom corners. Adhere to the real red layer.
